Contacting members - STATEMENT

This is an example statement that Clubs and Leagues can use when contacting members about GDPR.

The Club/League takes the view that, as you are asked to renew your membership each year, you do so on the understanding that the Club/League will keep you abreast of any events and will send you information pertaining to the Club. It also accepts that, as a Club/League for Table Tennis, you will be interested in Table Tennis matters.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Club Policy

- The GDPR covers the protection of Members regarding the processing of their personal data.
- The XXXX Club/XXXX League has an obligation to protect this data.
- The XXXX Club/XXXX League Club will hold Members' details securely on a database that is password-protected.
- The information held will be controlled by the Club/League staff.

- Members will be able to opt-in to any general marketing information that the Club, from time to time, may circulate.
