Eligibility Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All players must be a Player Member of Table Tennis England. Each Local League is eligible to enter one or more teams in each competition. Limits may be needed- but we will try to avoid. Players must have played at least 4 matches in the league represented in the competition during 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22 A player cannot play for more than one team in each category. A junior player having represented a League in a junior event shall be eligible to represent another League in a senior event provided they meet the necessary criteria above. A Player Licence is not required.
Structure	8 zones with teams allocated a zone on a geographical basis. Zones may be amalgamated. Zonal Rounds with preliminaries if needed and Finals to be played in groups or as a knockout at the discretion of Committee.
Teams	Minimum of 2 players, maximum of 4 players per team. Two players play two singles each and up to two different players may play doubles.
Playing Format	A v X, B v Y, Doubles, A v Y, B v X. 5 matches in total. All matches to be played.
Venues	Zonal Round venues to be arranged by or on behalf of the Committee Finals to be held at Draycott and Long Eaton TTC
