Practice/Warm Up.

On each day players will be able to practice on the tables 1 hour prior to the start of the first match. No access will be allowed early than this. We ask that only players use these tables, and not coaches to give priority to all players.

Registration & Court Access

Registration on both days will be 1 hour prior to the start of play. All players will be required to register on your arrival at the venue, **ON BOTH DAYS**, where you will be able to download/collect an event programme and any additional information required for the day.

Please note that only players are permitted on the match tables. Players take priority during practice at all times, coaches will be asked to vacate the court if other players are waiting.

Format

The event is run in a round-robin format using the players ranking order as at the January ranking list as per the prospectus for this event. All players will play 9 rounds of fixtures creating a league table for order of standings.

The points scoring system will be as follows:

- 2 points for winning a match
- 1 point for losing a completed match
- 0 points for losing by scratching or conceding

We politely request, that should a player withdraw during the competition, to make the competition referee aware of this prior to the withdrawal.

Draw & Schedule

The schedule and draw is listed in the event programme and a printable version will be uploaded onto the Table Tennis England website. The draw is subject to change at the discretion of the referee and all players will be notified of any changes.

This will be a 'Minimal Announcement' tournament so check the programme for details of the scheduled time and table for your matches, so players will be responsible for their own whereabouts and timings.

Clothing

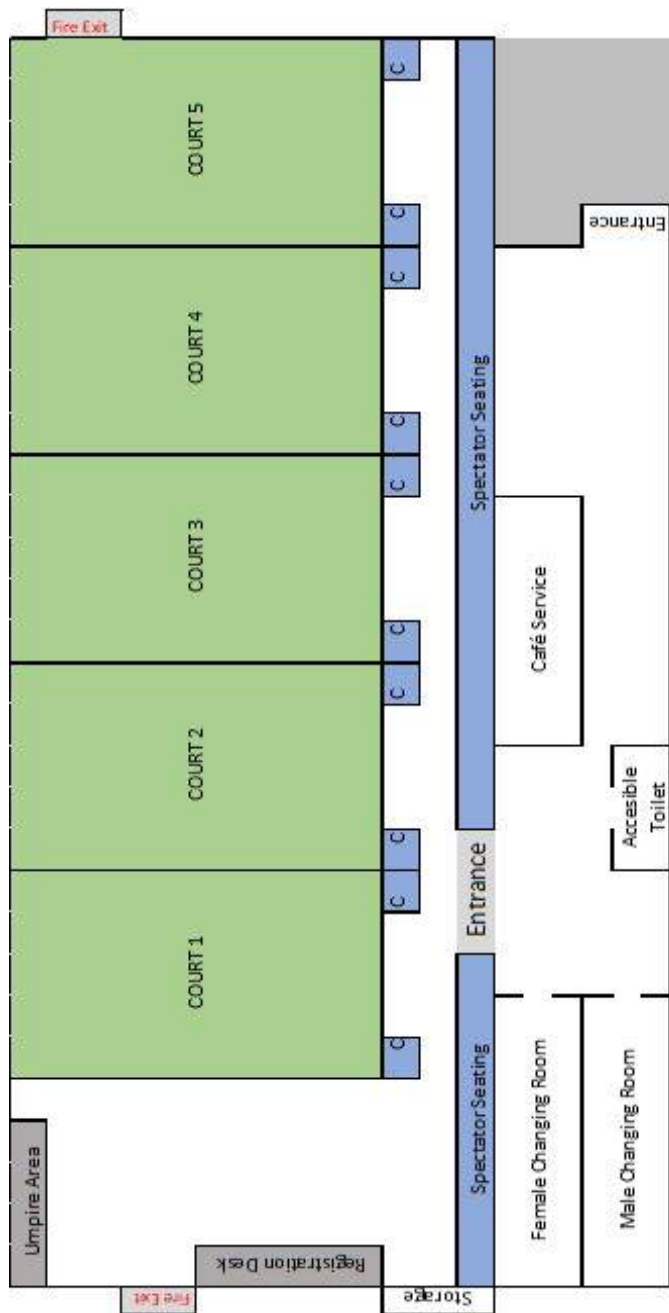
All players must have their name on the back of their shirt at all times whilst competing. They must also be suitably attired in sportswear and shoes. Failure to do so may result in the forfeit of any matches.

Video/Photo Footage

There will not be any streaming of the event, however our Media team will be in attendance to capture footage of the fixtures and any post-match interviews on the Sunday. These will all be available to view on the Table Tennis England website and social media pages.

Anyone other than Table Tennis England Staff, who wishes to take photos or videos at the event will need to register on arrival and have a photographer sticker clearly visible on your device.

Catering & Refreshments

The St Neots TT kitchen will be open for the duration of the competition, including hot breakfast and lunch. This is run by St Neots TT and will be serving both hot and cold food, drinks and refreshments.

Changing Rooms

There will be changing rooms and showers available at the venue, which are exclusive to the Table Tennis Competition. We have access to one male and one female changing room. Any valuables left will be at your own risk.

Spectator Area

We encourage spectators to attend this event and the venue will have viewing space. This will be a viewing window from the lounge area. We would like to minimise the number of people in the playing hall as much as possible to just players, coaches and officials where possible to allow smooth running of the competition.

This event is a limited access event and therefore access to the playing hall will be limited to the player and an adviser involved in a match ONLY. There are no exceptions to this. There is spectator viewing available for this event for where individuals who do not qualify as either of the 2 individuals listed above. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the venue.

Parking at the Venue:

There is a Car Park at the rear of the premises which is free of charge for all participants and specifically for St Neots TT visitors. For disabled badge holders there is parking at the entrance to the venue.
