Playing Schedule

Play will be on a group basis played in groups of three, four or five commencing at 9:00 am. The top 2 players in each group will be entered into the knockout stages, with a plate event for the remaining players. In the event of there being insufficient entries in any event the organising committee reserve the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. **Every entrant must be affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Compete Plus Member or affiliated as a TTE Compete member and have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence Fee with their entry form** or provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form
3. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the Entrant to the conditions of the Competition, including variations of ITTF regulations.
4. All matches shall be the best of five games. Preliminary matches will be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
5. Competitors must wear rubber soled shoes.
6. Clothing: Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
9. Players entering the Juniors event must have been born in 2003 or later, the Cadets event 2007 or later, Under 13's event 2009 or later, and Under 11's event 2011 or later.
10. There is a limit of two events any one player can enter, **an eligible age group and the one above.**
11. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the date of the draw.
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
13. Competitors must report to the Booking-In Control on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
14. The Referee's decision shall be final on point of law on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. **Playing Conditions** – Play throughout will be on 12 Butterfly tables with Butterfly Nets & Posts; Sanwei Pro Plus 3 Star 40+ Balls (white); Individual courts size 9 m x 4. 5m enclosed by surrounds; Gransprung sprung floor; Height of playing area 5m; General LED lighting at a minimum height of 5m. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.

3. **Refreshments** – Light refreshments and drinks will be available.
4. **Changing** – The venue offers full changing and shower facilities.
5. **Car Parking** – Free car parking (at owners' risk) is available at the venue and nearby car parks.
6. **Draw** – The draw will take place on Monday 21st February 2022, 10.00 am at 1 Malpas Road, Runcorn, Cheshire WA7 4AD.
7. **Entries** – If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
No refunds of entry fees will be made after the date of the draw.
8. **Admission** – There will be no charge for admission.
9. **Doping** – Doping control tests may take place.
10. **Practice** – There are no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
11. **Ranking Scheme** – Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England Computer Ranking Scheme.
12. **Notification** – Entrants will be notified of the time of their first match on the day.
13. **Prizes** – Trophies or medals will be awarded to the winner and runner up in each category.
14. **Accommodation** – Details of accommodation will be sent out with notification if requested.
15. The organising committee reserves the right to alter the above dramatically if necessary.
16. **P.A. System** – All matches will be announced on the P.A. System. Players must not leave the centre without permission of the Referee.
