Players will be split by standard into bands of 9 which will be played in one round-robin group. Entrants will get 8 games at their level.

Winners and runners up will be presented with medals.

#### **Tournament Information**

- 1. Notification competitors will receive an acknowledgment of entry, which will include the scheduled playing times for the opening matches in each event.
- 2. Entry forms these can be downloaded from the TTE Website, or from the Sussex County Website. All entry forms will be returned to the organiser by the closing date of **Friday 29th April 2022**.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 4. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made.
- 5. Admission there will be no charge for admission.
- 6. The venue provides toilet and changing facilities.
- 7. Free Car Parking is available at the venue (at the owner's risk).
- 8. Playing conditions play throughout will be with STAG Supreme 3\* Balls ITTF Approved (white), on 8 Butterfly / Donic Centrefold 25mm tables, with Butterfly nets and posts, each in an individual court measuring 9m x 4.5m enclosed by surrounds. LED lighting approx. 8m above the table (604 lux); with a floor to ceiling height of 8.5m. The flooring is composite non-slip flooring.
- 9. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
- 10. Practice there will be no separate practice facilities; competitors will be permitted to practice on tables, not in use at the discretion of the referee.
- 11. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection & Safeguarding Policies, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation, or a completed TTE authorisation form.
- 12. All bands will be based on the TTE Rating list current at the closing date.
- 13. Players without a rating will be placed where appropriate by the tournament organising committee.
- 14. Play will commence at 9am, practice tables will be available after registration from 8.30am.
- 15. Players are to bring their own refreshments.



#### **Tournament Regulations**

1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.

ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.

- 2. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF, and is not affiliated to TTE. Players who only hold Compete membership of Table Tennis England may pay a Single Competition Licence Fee as a one-off upgrade and this provides entitlement to participate in this competition only. It is not possible to acquire membership of Table Tennis England at the tournament.
- 3. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 4. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
- 5. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 6. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.
- 7. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
- 8. All competitors may be required to umpire one knockout match in each event entered after being knocked out.
- 9. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 11. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
- 12. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 13. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
- 14. Competitors must have been born in 2003 or later.
