6. Formats

The format of the Singles categories will be group stages, followed by knockout matches played to the best of 5 games, 11 up. The format of the Doubles categories will be straight knockout matches played to the best of 5 games, 11 up.

Table Tennis England reserves the right for changes to format should numbers not be suitable, or to cancel the competition if there are less than 8 entries. There is no consolation event.

7. Weighting

These events carry a Table Tennis England ranking weighting of x2

8. Invitations

Table Tennis England will invite up to 24 boys and 24 girls for the U11 age categories as well as 48 boys and 48 girls for the U13 age categories. This will include 2 wild card invites for each Singles competition.

9. Eligibility

Table Tennis England will only invite athletes for the above event who:

- a) Are affiliated to Table Tennis England, holding a valid Table Tennis England Complete Plus membership and in good standing.
- b) Are eligible to represent England in ITTF and ETTU approved competitions and have valid proof of British Citizenship.
- c) Are not currently under disqualification or suspension under the rules of Table Tennis England or ITTF & ETTU.
- d) Are not currently serving any sanction for an anti-doping rule violation under any relevant anti-doping rules.

Athletes may apply for mitigating circumstances, in the event that they are unable to complete the above requirement. Athletes should apply to the Tournament Director as soon as possible after the 22/8 April 2022 Ranking list. Injury and international representation are reasons that will be looked on favourably.

10. Criteria for invitation

Table Tennis England will invite eligible players from 1 to 22 (for boys and girls in the U11 age groups), plus 2 wildcards, and 1 to 46 (for boys and girls in the U13 age groups), plus two wildcards, on the Table Tennis England 22/8 April 2022 Ranking list. (It is the players' responsibility to ensure they do not drop off the ranking list due to inactivity, which happens after 5 inactive periods). Should an athlete decline their invitation, the next eligible player listed on the 22/8 April 2022 Ranking list will be invited up to 40 for the U11 events and 64 for the U13 event.

Athletes can only compete in the singles event which they have been invited.

If the minimum entries have not been met for the U11 age group categories, for both boys and girls, entry applications are invited for consideration. Serious applications only will be considered; video footage against a specific skills matrix, as well as a written testimonial from a qualified and licensed Table Tennis England coach, will be required for an objective assessment to be made. Please do not make a speculative enquiry unless you are confident in the appropriate ability of the applicant. TTE are under no obligation to extend invitations beyond the ranking eligibility stated above. If you wish to make an application, please contact mark.pinder@tabletennisengland.co.uk ASAP.

The deadline for submission of video evidence and testimonials will be Friday 29th April.

Doubles:

Entry in to the U13 Doubles events will be restricted to 24 pairs for boys doubles and 24 pairs for girls doubles. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis with the exception of entries from any of the first eight seeds in the U13 boys singles and any of the first eight seeds in the U13 girls singles events, whose entries will be accepted provided a correctly completed entry form is received from both partners with payment. Only players who have been invited to play in the Singles events are eligible to enter the Doubles events.

11. Timing

Invitations are to be sent after the publication of the 22/8 2022 Ranking list and Table Tennis England will endeavor to complete invitations to qualified players within 14 days after the 22/8 2022 Ranking list is published, to allow athletes to enter the event, subject to them completing the relevant forms and payment.

Seeding for the draw will be based on the May 22/9 Ranking list

12. Racket testing

Racket tests may be implemented at this event, randomly selected according to ITTF regulations.

The tournament will be played on 16 tables in courts 10m x 5m, practice tables will also be available in the hall.

Extract from ITTF Eligibility Regulations (for information only - not part of Schedule)

- 3.8.3 A player is eligible to represent an Association only if he is a national of the country in which that Association has jurisdiction, except that a player who has already represented an Association of which he or she was not a national in accordance with previous rules may retain that eligibility.
- 3.8.3.1 Where the players of more than one Association have the same nationality, a player may represent one of these Associations only if he or she was born in or has his or her main residence, in the territory controlled by that Association.
- 3.8.3.2 A player who is eligible to represent more than 1 Association shall have the right to choose which of the relevant Associations he will represent.
- 3.8.5 A player shall not represent different Associations within a period of 3 years.
