TOURNAMENT INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the Tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Part A and B, or in this form.
4. The competition is open to all entrants – Juniors U19s born in 2003 or later and Veterans born in 1981 or earlier.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11 points (2 clear points if the score reaches 10-10). All competitors will be required to umpire matches and if a wheelchair player is due to play, an extra competitor shall act as a Ball Collector. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
6. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival and should not leave the centre without obtaining permission from the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match.
7. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
8. The referee reserves the right to cancel/merge events if entry levels are low.
9. There will be no separate practice facilities. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THE VENUE HAS LIMITED CHANGING FACILITIES.**
11. Play will take place on 3 Butterfly tables with Butterfly nets and Butterfly poles. TSP 3 Star 40+ white balls will be used.
12. Tables will be individually courted. Min ceiling: 4.2m from floor to ceiling, Court Size: 9m x 4.5m with surrounding barriers on each court. Light intensity minimum 300 lux general lighting 4.2m above the floor. Flooring is a wooden floor.
13. No seating is allowed outside the playing courts without permission from the referee. Players may rest on the stage.
14. Please bring your own refreshments. Tap and boiling water are available in the kitchen.
15. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping control tests may take place.
16. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
17. Car parking is available free of charge. There will be no charge for admission of spectators. Due to limited spaces at venue, only one spectator/coach per player is permitted to spectate.
18. **COVID19** - Please check latest Government's guidelines.
19. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
20. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry, fees will not be refunded after the closing date. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.
21. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
22. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made.
23. Notification – players will receive an acknowledgment of entry via email.
24. The closing date for entries will be midnight on **Sunday 10th July 2022**. The draw for matches will take place on **Wednesday 13th July 2022**.
25. The draw will be sent to all entrants by **Thursday 14th July 2022**.
26. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images of anyone other than their own child must register with the event organizer or present their professional identification.
