Format

Players will be ranked on the latest computer ranking list, no restriction on gender. (Separate gender groups will run if enough entries)

Cadets – 32 max entries allowed, Juniors – max 16 entries allowed

Groups of 8 with a round robin per group, groups will be mixed if there are not enough boys/girls in each category. The organising committee reserves the right to modify group sizes in light of entries, any amendments to be advised via email.

Registration and practice from 08.15, with play to commence at 09.00

ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday 8th July 2022

The tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to TTE. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete Member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with their entry form.
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. The competition is open to a maximum of 32 Cadet players and 16 Junior players. Groups may be mixed between boys/girls if not sufficient entries for a particular event.
- 6. Players will be expected to umpire as per the group schedule.
- 7. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
- 8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping control tests may take place.
- 11. All Competitors must report to the Booking-In Control on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 12 The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 13. Players must have been born in 2003 or later for the junior event, and in 2007 or later for the cadet event. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Entry form these can be downloaded from the TTE Website, or from the organiser. All entry forms will be returned to the organiser by the closing date of Friday 8th July 2022, and all cheques to be made payable to .St Mary's Table Tennis Hull
- 2. Entries forms received with no fees will not be accepted, if it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 3. Draw the draw will take place at 1900 on Monday 11th July 2022, at 37 Golf Links Road, Hull
- 4. Admission there will be no charge for admission.
- 5. Playing conditions play throughout will be with Stiga 3* Perform Balls (white), Sponeta tables, Stiga nets and posts, each in an individual court measuring 9m x 5m enclosed by surrounds, wooden flooring, general florescent lighting approximately 5m above the table. Minimum height of playing area (floor to ceiling) approximately 6 metres
- 6. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
- 7. Free Car Parking is available at the centre (at owner's risk).
- 8. Practice there will be no separate practice facilities, competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the referee.
- 9. All Group Winners and Runners-Up will receive trophies.
- 10. Notification competitors will receive an acknowledgement of entry after the draw, which will include the scheduled playing times for the opening matches in each event. This document will admit the entrant to the venue.
- 11. Changing facilities with showers are available
- 12. Hot and cold refreshments and snacks will be on sale.
- 13 In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form.
- 14. Play will commence at 9am, practice tables will be available after registration from 0815.
- 15. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the draw date.
