## Tournament Information

1. Entry form – All entries must be sent to the Table Tennis England Events Department by the closing date.
2. **Entries – Entry forms shall only be submitted with full payment of fees, entries will not be confirmed until both entry form and payment have been received.**
3. Playing conditions – Play throughout will be **Joola 2000S Tables, Joola WM nets & posts, the match ball will be Tibhar 40+SL 3\* plastic ball (white)**. Individual court size 10m x 5m minimum enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
4. Changing – Facilities maybe restricted in the centre.
5. There will be a practical limit for entrants and entries to specific events. It may not be possible to accept all entries. This will be determined by when your entry is submitted/ paid for. All entries should be considered provisional until confirmed, and any unsuccessful entries will be refunded.
6. Practice – There are no separate practice facilities.
7. Grand Prix ranking weighting is set at x1.75
8. Admission for Spectators may be restricted if necessitated by COVID regulations that are in place at the time.
9. Doping – Doping control tests may take place.
10. Notification – Entrants will be notified of the time of their first match on each day by email.
11. P.A. system – All groups and knockout matches will be announced on the P.A. system. Players must not leave the centre without permission of the Referee. Repeat calls for a player will be limited to three per day.
12. Player number – A £10 deposit is included on the entry form. This will be refunded when the player returns the number, signed by the Referee to indicate that the Referee is satisfied that the player has carried out any umpiring duties required. **Note that number deposits are only refundable on the day of the tournament.**
13. Refunds for entries will only be issued to players who have withdrawn in the below timescale:
  - Prior to the deadline date – Full refund minus a £5 admin charge.
  - After the deadline date and prior to the draw date – Full refund minus a £10 admin charge.
  - After the draw there will be no refunds available.

If you have a 'Compete' Membership you can upgrade this to a 'Compete Plus' for the remainder of the season, or you can pay for a Single Competition Licence fee along with your entry, which is a cost of £10.00, and will upgrade you to the 'Compete Plus' for the competition only.
