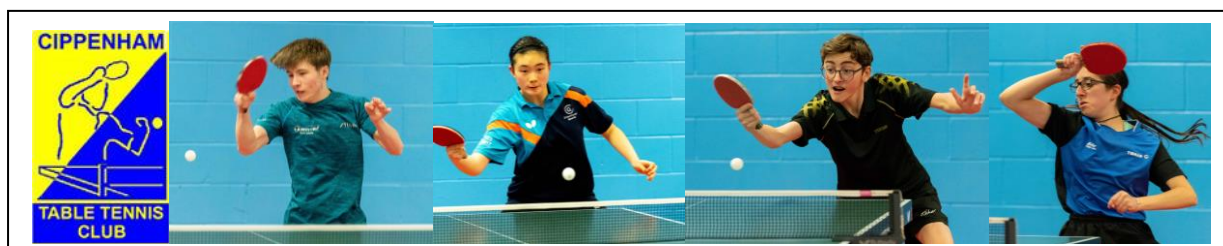

THIS SHEET IS TO BE RETAINED BY THE ENTRANT - REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Complete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF, and is not affiliated to TTE. An entrant only affiliated as a Complete Member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with their entry form.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to this tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to this tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Part A or B in this form.
4. Players may be expected to umpire group matches. All knockout matches will be umpired by a qualified umpire.
5. Play throughout for all events will be on a knockout basis except for the first round of each singles event, which will be on a group basis. In a group or "round robin" competition each member of the group shall compete against every other member. Two match points will be awarded for a win, one for a loss in a played match, and zero for an un-played or uncompleted match. The ranking order shall be decided primarily by the number of match points gained. If at the completion of the group two or more members of the group have gained the same number of match points the equality shall be resolved as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
6. All matches will be the best of five games; each game will be up to eleven points.
7. Competitors in Junior Events must have been born after 31st December 2003. Competitors in Cadet Events must have been born after 31st December 2007.
8. Rackets will conform to ITTF Regulation 3.2.1.3.
9. Clothing shall comply with TTE Regulations Part A
10. At the discretion of the Referee competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables not in use. NO CROSS KNOCKING. Dedicated practice tables will not be available.
11. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
12. The preliminary round of all events will be played in groups of 3 or 4 players (subject to late withdrawals from competitors), following which the players finishing first and second will qualify for the championship knockout events and the player finishing third or fourth will qualify for the consolation events. In the event of several non-arrivals resulting in incomplete groups the Referee reserves the right to disband the highest numbered incomplete group and to redistribute the players present in that group among other incomplete groups to fill any vacancies.
13. Decisions on points of fact by an Umpire or Assistant Umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, in any dispute as to the interpretation of these Regulations and in any matter not covered by them.
14. Entrants who do not attend the tournament without a reason acceptable to the Referee may be reported to the Table Tennis England.
15. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping control tests may take place
16. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations
17. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up within the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
18. All players are requested to wear a shirt with their name prominently displayed on their back, which must be worn at all times when a competitor is participating in any event.
19. An Assistant Umpire will be appointed for finals only at the Referee's discretion.
20. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
21. Notification will be sent after the draw has been made, notifying competitors of the first match time for each event they have entered, if they have provided a valid **email address**
22. Trophies will be given to winners and runners-up of both main and consolation events.
23. The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
24. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
25. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
26. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. The entry form should be completed in **block capitals** using a ballpoint pen and should be scanned and emailed to Steve Piercey, (tel: 07919 210016), together with Payment, to arrive not later than the closing date, Saturday 5th November 2022.

Entrants (and where applicable parents) must sign the undertaking to "observe regulations, abide by the decisions of the Referee, and fulfil the schedule of play". Unsigned entries (or entries signed by a coach) will not be accepted.

Substituting names from one competitor to another directly will not be allowed. Before the closing date, this can effectively be achieved by cancelling one entry and submitting a new entry form, with the new date being recorded in case of needing to restrict entries due to entry date.

Payment shall be by PayPal - see below. Entries will not be accepted unless full payment has been made by the closing date.

The draw will take place on Monday 14th November 2022.

Unfortunately, no refunds of entry fees will be given after the draw has taken place

Competitors will be notified of the times of their opening matches; at least 3 days' notice will be given.

Junior 4-star tournaments - Entry Qualifications

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt, except that all valid entries for Junior Boys rated 1-50 in the Rating List at the closing date and for Junior Girls, Cadet Boys and Cadet Girls rated 1-32 will be accepted, with priority thereafter being given to Junior Boys rated 51-500 and Junior Girls rated 33-250.

VENUE

There is no charge for admission to the venue.

Snacks & drinks and changing rooms are available at Cippenham Table Tennis Centre.

Free car Parking is available at the Centre at owners' risk.

Smoking is not allowed in any area of the venue.

PLAYING CONDITIONS

Play will be on 9 Butterfly tables and nets with TIBHAR 40+sl white plastic balls, Minimum court size will be 10m by 5m and will have full surrounds. Minimum height of playing area is 4.0m. Minimum height of the general fluorescent lighting is 4.0m with intensity 600 lux over the playing surface: Tarkett Compact 2.0 plastic floor over sprung wood base.

TABLE TENNIS ENGLAND RANKING SYSTEM

All match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England ranking system.

The entry fee includes a charge for the administration of this system.
