TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entry Form – All entries must be sent and received by the Tournament Organiser by the closing date
2. **Entries - Entry forms shall be submitted with full payment of fees, entries will not be confirmed until both entry form and payment have been received.**
3. Playing Conditions – Play throughout will be on Butterfly tables, Butterfly nets and posts, the match ball will be Butterfly R40 3* plastic ball (white). Individual court size 10m x 5m minimum enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
4. Refreshments – Are available in the Centre.
5. Accommodation – Is available at various hotels in Jersey.
An excellent rate of £55 per person per night sharing a double or twin room on bed and breakfast basis has been negotiated at the Ambassadeur Hotel on St Clement's Coast Road, which is within close walking distance of the venue. There are a limited number of rooms so please book early to avoid disappointment. There is a supplement for single rooms (£70 per room), double room for sole occupancy (£85 per room) and sea view (£14 per room). To book contact the hotel directly. 6. Changing – Facilities are available at the Centre
7. Entries – If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on last received, first out basis. Grand Prix tournaments are often oversubscribed, so enter early to avoid disappointment.
8. Practice – There are no separate practice facilities. Unused tables may be allocated to practice
9. Admission for spectators is permitted.
10. Doping – Doping control tests may take place. The UK Anti-Doping Rules apply to all participants of the sport, including Minors, and they make all participants subject to drug Testing. For the purposes of those rules, consent of a parent or guardian to the Testing of a Minor is deemed to follow automatically from the fact that the Minor has been permitted by their parent or guardian to participate in Table Tennis. Therefore, any Minors participating in the sport may be subject to drug Testing.
11. Retirement from competitions – all records relating to an athlete's retirement will be kept by Table Tennis Jersey & Table Tennis England and shared with UKAD when requested.
12. All participants will be allocated a player number for the competition, however no player numbers will be provided and are not required to be worn at the competition.

13. Notification – Entrants will be notified of the time of their first match on each day by e-mail.
14. P.A. System – All matches will be announced at the Table Tennis Centre. Players must not leave the centre without permission of the Referee. Repeat calls for a player will be limited to three per day.
15. Player Number – A £10 deposit is included on the entry form. This will be refunded when the referee is satisfied that the player has carried out any umpiring duties required under Regulation 4. Note that number deposits are only refundable on the days of the tournament.
16. Car Parking - Car Parking (at owners' risk) is available at the venue
17. Refunds for entries will only be issued to players who have withdrawn in the below time scale.
 - Prior to the deadline date – Full refund minus £5 admin Charge
 - After the deadline date and prior to the draw date – Full refund minus £10 admin charge
 - After the draw there will be no refunds available.

Categories and Entry Fees

Players can compete in the below categories across the 3 days. The first event that you enter will cost £50 of which £10 of this is a deposit which is refundable. Each additional category that you enter will cost £10 each.
