A Table Tennis England Satellite Grand Prix Tournament



TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a 'Compete Plus' member to Table Tennis England (TTE), have a TTE membership number or hold a 'Jersey Table Tennis membership or be a member of another national association in membership of the ITTF, or have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with his/her entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another national association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competition apply except those relating to matters covered by items marked (x) in the entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
4. All competitors will be required to umpire.
5. All matches will be the best of 5 games. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis, with the exception of the preliminary rounds in all singles and doubles events, which will be in groups of four for men and women (At the Referee's discretion, banded singles events may be played in groups of three) with the first two players qualifying. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions except that where a player concedes a match he/she shall receive -3 group points (x).
6. Team Events: A team shall consist of two players. A match will consist of 2 singles matches followed by a doubles match and then (if necessary, or time permitting and agreed by both teams and the Referee) reverse singles. Initial matches may be played in a group depending on the entry.
7. Competitors in Veteran events must have been born before 1 January 1983, competitors in Under 21 events must be born after 31 December 2001.
8. Players must not wear shirts that are predominantly white.
9. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
10. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
12. All competitors must report to the control table on arrival and must not leave the venue without first obtaining permission from the Referee.
13. Entry to banded events are restricted by player's ratings, according to the Table Tennis England Ratings List current at the closing date for entries. Restrictions are as follows:

Men's

Band 1: 1501-1800

Band 2: 1101-1500

Band 3: 901-1100

Band 4: 551-900

Band 5: 351-550

Band 6: 0-350

Women's

Band 1: 1201-1600

Band 2: 901-1200

Band 3: 701-900

Band 4: 0-700

Players may enter their own band and/or the one above. The organising committee reserves the right to give dummy ratings to any entrant who does not appear on the current Table Tennis England Ratings list. (Dummy ratings are for tournament purposes only, players will have zero points on the ratings list unless they are in the top 30% of the ITTF World Ranking List. Players with an existing rating can also be given a dummy rating to be more reflective of ability).

Banded Events – If you do not have a Table Tennis England Rating, in most cases you will qualify for Band 6 (Men) Band 4 (Women). Remember, you are entitled to play in your own Band and/or the one above.

IMPORTANT: the level of the event at which a player gains their initial rating may constrain the potential value of that initial rating. If an unrated player is experienced and capable, as opposed to a beginner, it is important to a) ensure the event is the correct level in order that the initial rating is gained against opponents of an appropriate rating, and b) actively liaise with the Referee of the event to ensure that the unrated players' event seeding/ banding/ grouping is appropriate. If an event entry form does not include the ability to state this information, it is recommended that an unrated player contact the Referee directly prior to the event draw. Failure to do so may result in an undervalued initial rating, although this will normalise with further competition.

14. Should there be insufficient entries in any event, the Referee reserves the right to cancel/merge such event and/or place the entrants in a similar event. Table Tennis Jersey reserves the right to reduce the prize money in the Men's and Women's singles should entries fall below 16 per specific event and would be proportional to the entry size.
15. The use of rackets prepared with glue containing VOCs will not be allowed.
16. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law on any question arising not provided for in these regulations or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.
17. Any Jersey earnings/ tax implications, and/ or UK or Jersey visa implications, arising from prize winnings at this event are strictly the responsibility of the participant.
