Tournament Regulations

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
5. All events will be played in groups of 3 with the top 2 to qualify for the knockout stages, with the exception of the Prizefighter event.
6. All matches will be best of 5 sets.
7. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
8. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
9. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. 10. **PLAYERS CAN ONLY ENTER THEIR OWN AGE GROUP AND THE AGE GROUP DIRECTLY ABOVE THEM, PLUS THE PRIZE FIGHTER EVENT WHICH IS MIXED AND OPEN TO ALL.**

PRIZE FIGHTER EVENT

100% of the Prizefighter entry fee will go into the prize fund.

ALL GROUP WINNERS WILL GO INTO POOL A AND PLAY FOR 50% OF THE ENTIRE PRIZE FUND.

ALL GROUP RUNNERS UP GO INTO POOL B AND PLAY FOR 30% OF THE ENTIRE PRIZE FUND.

ALL THIRD PLACED WILL GO INTO POOL C AND PLAY FOR 20% OF THE ENTIRE PRIZE FUND.

3 IN A GROUP AND ALL ARE GUARANTEED TO PROGRESS INTO THE KNOCKOUT STAGES. IN THEORY EACH PLAYER SHOULD BE PLAYING A PLAYER OF A SIMILAR STANDARD IN THE KNOCKOUT STAGES, AS ALL THE 3RD PLACED WILL ONLY PLAY OTHER 3RD PLACED COMPETITORS.

ALL THE 2ND PLACED COMPETITORS WILL ONLY PLAY OTHER 2ND PLACED COMPETITORS AND ALL THE 1ST PLACED WILL ONLY PLAY OTHER 1ST PLACED COMPETITORS. THE HIGHER YOU FINISH IN THE GROUP THE MORE MONEY YOU ARE PLAYING FOR.

11. Players entering the under 13 singles must have been born in 2010 or later.
12. Players entering the under 15 singles must have been born in 2008 or later.
13. Players entering the under 17 singles must have been born in 2006 or later.
14. Players entering the under 19 singles must have been born in 2004 or later.

15. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use.
16. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
17. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
18. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
19. Trophies will be awarded to the winners and runners up in all events apart from the Prizefighter event where cash prizes will be given out.
20. The committee reserves the right to mix boys and girls in the event of too few competitors in any event.

Playing Conditions:

1. Play will be on 8 Butterfly tables with Joola posts and nets.
2. Balls used will be white Decathlon Pongori C40+ 3 star poly balls.
3. Each table will be in an individual court enclosed by surrounds.
4. Each court will be 9 metres long by 4.5 metres wide.
5. Minimum height of playing area (floor to ceiling) is 5 metres.
6. Minimum height of lighting from floor is 5 metres.
7. Lighting is general LED and 500 lux.
8. Flooring is semi-sprung timber
9. Score indicators will be used for all matches.
