TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1.Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- 2.TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3.ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4.Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5.All matches shall be the best of five games to 11 points. All events will start as group matches with the top 2 going through to the knock-out rounds and all other players going through to positions matches knockout. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee in light of entries received.
- 6. Players will be expected to umpire as per the group schedule.
- 7. Competitors may enter two events subject to eligibility, one AM event and one PM event
- 8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main color of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended).
- 9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping control tests may take place.
- 11. All Competitors must report to the Booking-In Control on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 12 The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 13. Players must have been born in 2008 or later for the Cadet event, in 2010 or later for the U13 event and in 2012 or later for the U11 event. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.

- 15. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Entry form these can be downloaded from the TTE Website, or from the organiser. All entry forms will be returned to the organizer **or emailed to <u>shanebradley964@gmail.com</u>** by the closing date of **Friday 24**th **March2023**, and all cheques to be made payable to .St Mary's Table Tennis Hull. Entry fees can also be paid by BACS, details on the entry form.
- 2. Entries if it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 3. Draw the draw will take place at 1900 on Friday $25^{\mbox{th}}$ March 2023.
- 4. Admission there will be no charge for admission.
- 5. Playing conditions play throughout will be with Gewo Select Pro 3* Balls (white), 6 Sponeta tables, Stiga nets and posts, each in an individual court measuring 9m x 5m enclosed by surrounds, wooden flooring, Florescent lighting approximately 5m above the table.
- 6. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
- 7. Car Parking is available at the Centre (at owner's risk).
- 8. Practice there will be no separate practice facilities, competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the referee.
