## The 47th NATIONAL INDIVIDUAL FINALS



We have a group system of play and TWO from each group go through to the knockout stages. There is no consolation event. We cannot announce every match as it would mean almost constant use of the public address system.

Your matches as shown in the programme will be under the strict direction of your table controllers. **Hence you must stay in constant contact with them.** If you are not available to play when you are called you will automatically be scratched from that match. Your co-operation is needed as we have over 800 matches to play today!!

The system for deciding the final positions in each group is calculated as per ITTF Regulations for International Competitions 3.07.05:

For each match in a group, 2 match points will be awarded for a win, 1 match point for a loss in a played match and 0 match points for a loss in an unplayed or unfinished match.

The ranking order shall be determined primarily by the number of match points gained.

If two or more members of the group have gained the same number of match points their relative positions shall be determined by the results only of the matches between those being equal taking successively the ratio of wins to losses in games and points).

All group matches will be played on tables within a designated block. All players except the under-11s and the under-13 girls will be given a schedule of their matches and umpiring responsibilities. In the under-11s and under-13 girls' events, the winner of each match is asked to remain at the table and umpire the next match, whilst the loser returns the score sheet and match ball to the control table

No player, regardless of age, will be allowed to buy or consume alcoholic drinks on the premises during the Championships.

English Schools Table Tennis and Table Tennis England are rightly proud of their reputation for good and sporting behaviour at all of its events. I am sure that you will do all you can to maintain this.

Finally, we wish all competitors good luck and I hope that you enjoy your time here at the National Finals.
