TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by email to Brett Holt by no later than Friday 18th August 2023.
- 2. The Draw will be held on Thursday 24th August 2023.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. Late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the appropriate event after the closing date.
- 4. Payment must be made **by bank transfer** before emailing the entry form.

- 5. There is ample free parking. There are changing rooms & shower facilities too. There's a cafe at the venue.
- 6. DHS DJ40+ 3-star white balls will be used.
- 7. Play will take place on up to **18 Donic/Butterfly** tables with **Butterfly Europa** nets and posts and with **Butterfly** scoring machines.
- 8. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 10m; Minimum Court Size: 10m X 5m.
- 9. Lighting is general and fluorescent lighting. The minimum Light intensity is 500 lux. Minimum height of lighting: 10m.
- 10. The venue has wooden sprung flooring. 11. There will be no admission charge.
- 12. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 day of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 2 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with the referee
- 13. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
- 14. The planned format for the 2 player team event is a progressive system where all teams get the same amount of matches & end up with a final placing. For the singles we will have a double-group system followed by a knockout. The groups will be organised based on the current ranking list. Unranked players may be placed in a higher group position if deemed appropriate by the Organising Committee. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee in light of entries received. Players looking for scratch entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed, is riskier.
- 15. There will be prize money and trophies for players reaching the quarter finals or better in both the main draws & the consolation events. Prize Money. £1500 Men's Winner, £750 Men's Runner- up, £250 Men's losing semi-finalists, £150 Men's losing quarter-finalists, £500 Women's Winner, £250 Women's runner up, £125 Women's losing semi-finalists, £75 Women's losing quarter-finalists. £150 Men's Consolation Winner, £100 Men's Consolation Runner-up, £50 Men's Consolation losing semi-finalists, £25 Men's Consolation losing quarter-finalists. £75 Women's Consolation Winner, £50 Women's Consolation runner-up, £30 Women's Consolation losing semi-finalists, £20 Women's Consolation losing quarter-finalists, £500 Team Event Winners, £250 Team Runners-up, £100 Team losing semi-finalists & £50 Team losing quarter-finalists. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

- 1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 2. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to TTE. Players who only hold Compete membership of Table Tennis England may pay a Single Competition Licence Fee as a one-off upgrade and this provides entitlement to participate in this competition only. It is not possible to acquire membership of Table Tennis England at the tournament.
- 3. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
- 4. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 5. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
- 6. All competitors may be required to umpire one knockout match per event entered after being knocked out.
- 7. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended
- 8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 9. Speed gluing, boosting & tuning are not allowed.
- 10. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 11. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 12. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/aboutus/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/
- 13. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary.
