TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1 Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the Entrant to the Conditions of the Competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games.
6. Preliminary matches will be on a group basis and the final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
7. The top 3 players from each group will progress to the knockout stage.
8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use.
9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
10. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
12. All competitors must report to the referee on arrival and should not leave the premises without first obtaining the referee's permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
13. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the referee reserves the right to cancel that event or merge events or place the entrant in a similar event.
14. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations.
15. Players entering the cadet singles must be born in 2009 or later, and junior singles must have been born in 2005 or later.
16. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols and Table Tennis England deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
17. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
18. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. The UK Anti-Doping Rules apply to all persons entering an event or competition, for whichever is the longer of a) the length of their membership or licence period; or b) 12 months from the date of their participation, whether or not the entrant or licence holder is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.
21. System of play: All events will be 3 groups of 4 players, followed by a knockout stage. The top 3 from each group will go through to the quarter final stage with the top 2 seeds getting a bye.

Tournament Information

1. Extra Entry Forms can be obtained via email from the Organiser.
2. The Draw will take place on Saturday 16th September 2023.
3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
4. Practice – There will be no separate practice facilities but competitors will be allowed to practice on tables not currently in use at the discretion of the referee.
5. Admission – There is no entry charge for supporters or spectators.
6. Free car parking is available at the Sports Centre.
7. There are changing facilities.
8. Tables: Butterfly Europa 25
9. Nets and posts: Butterfly National League
10. Balls: Butterfly R40+ 3*
11. Courts: 8.5x4m x3m high. Barrier surrounds for each court.
12. Lighting: Spotlights throughout. Some are directly above courts.
13. Flooring: Wooden laminate sports flooring.
14. Score indicators: Used for all matches.
15. Catering: No hot food available on site. Vending machines available for snacks.
16. Prizes will be in the form of trophies for winners and runner's up, as well as goodie bags for winners.
