

SELECT COMMITTEES

Second amendment to Standing Orders

- 19.3 Reports from existing Select Committee Chairs including recommendations as to whether they should continue and whether they are will to continue as Chair - - Chairs will be asked to provide these in advance.
- 19.4 Call for any suggested additional Select Committee to be formed.
- 19.5 Council to vote on the re-appointment of existing and any additional Select Committee by a show of hands en-bloc unless there are objections in which case the vote will be for each Select Committee in turn.
- 19.6 Appointment of Chairs of Select Committee – call for nomination for Chairs of all Select Committee and, should a ballot be necessary for any Select Committee, to vote by show of hands on the Chair to be appointed.
- 19.7 Call for National Councillors to nominate themselves to the appropriate Chair for the appointed Select Committee they are interested in – after the meeting Select Committee Chairs will then review the number of nominations they have received and, if they consider the number impractical, will inform the National Council Chair what they think the appropriate number should be. The National Council Chair will then organise a ballot of National Councillors to determine which nominees go forward to serve on the appropriate Select Committee.
