TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED <u>by email</u> by Rory Scott by no later than 16th Febuary 2024. Send payment <u>before</u> emailing the entry form. Please only send page 4, not the whole document. You can download free program Adobe Adolix Split & Merge to split pdfs into individual pages. If you'd prefer a copy of the entry form in Word format please contact Brett Holt on <u>brettholtuk@gmail.com</u>.
- 2. The Draw will be held on Tuesday 20th February 2024.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. Late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the appropriate event after the closing date.
- 4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing date (or immediately for late entries).

- 5. There will be a strict <u>surcharge of £5</u> for those who enter and/or pay late or come for a scratch entry on the day.
- 6. Sandwich rolls, hot and cold drinks & snacks will be available for purchase from the Referee/Organiser.
- 7. DHS DJ40+ 3-star white balls will be used.
- 8. Play will take place on 9 Donic tables with Donic nets and posts and with Donic/Joola scoring machines.
- 9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 7m; Minimum Court Size: 9m X 4.5m.
- 10. Lighting is general & fluorescent lighting. The minimum Light intensity is 300 lux. Minimum height of lights: 7m
- 11. The venue has wooden sprung flooring.
- 12. There is ample free parking. There are changing rooms and shower facilities.
- 13. There will be no admission charge.
- 14. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 day of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out at least 3 days before the event. If you do not receive either, please get in touch with the referee, or organiser.
- 15. No refunds or transfers are given after the closing date under any circumstances.
- 16. The planned format is mainly groups of 4, with some groups of 3 players. In all events, after the initial group stage, the top 2 players go into the main draw knock-out & the remaining players go into the consolation draw knock-out. For events with less than 7 players, the format will be round robin (all play all). The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee in light of entries received. Players looking for late entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed, is riskier.
- 17. There will be medals for the winners & runners-up in the main draw of each event and certificates for consolation event winners.
- 18. There will be a Table Tennis 365 Trade stand at the tournament.
- 19. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
- 20. Competitors may enter 1 or 2 events. If playing in 2 events, it must be one-morning event & one-afternoon event. See page 1 for the schedule.
- 21. Players will automatically be placed in their own age group events and/or the one above, depending on whether they are playing morning/afternoon/both and will be placed in their own gender events. Girls over 15 but under 18 playing in the morning will be placed in Mixed U18. Any players wanting to play in an older age group than that for which they are eligible will need to give a valid reason for doing so. U19s can play in Boys/Girls U19 and/or Mixed U19.
- 22. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 23. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/
- 24. TTE, the Organiser and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff, or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

- 1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to TTE. Players who only hold Compete membership of Table Tennis England may pay a Single Competition Licence Fee as a one-off upgrade and this provides entitlement to participate in this competition only. It is not possible to acquire membership of Table Tennis England at the tournament.
- 4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
- 6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low. No refunds or transfers will be offered should merging occur.
- 8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
- 9. All competitors may be required to umpire one knockout match in each event entered after being knocked out. Please report to the referee for umpiring once you have lost in the knockout round.
- 10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings, or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks, and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers, or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
- 13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
- 15. Competitors must have been born in 2012 or later for the Boys Under 12s, 2011 or later for the Boys Under 13s, 2010 or later for the Boys Under 14s, 2009 or later for the Boys/Girls Under 15s, 2006 or later for the Mixed Under 18s, 2005 or later for the Boys/Girls Under 19s and 2005 only for the Mixed U19s.
