The tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme. Players will be ranked based on the current computer rating points and ranking / rating points, no restriction on gender (separate gender groups will run if enough entries) based on a 2* Tournament.

PROVISIONAL PLAYING SCHEDULE

Cadets - 16 max entries Juniors - 16 max entries

Players will be ranked based on the latest computer ranking list, no restriction on gender (separate gender groups will run if there are enough entries). Groups of 8 with a round robin per group. Groups will be mixed. The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments to times will be communicated via email.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

- Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to TTE. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete Member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with their entry form.
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 3. The competition is open to a maximum of 16 cadet players and 16 junior
- 4. Group sizes based on entrants, groups will be mixed between male/female.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. All players will be required to umpire as scheduled during their group matches.
- 6. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 8. All matches shall be the best of five games.
- 9. Doping shall not take place either before or during play; and doping control tests may take place.
- 10. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to huddersfieldttcompetitions@gmail.com. Full payment at the time of registration will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.
- 11. Playing conditions Sanwei 3* white balls, 6 Sponeta 22mm tables, 2 Butterfly tables 22mm tables, Butterfly & Contra & Imperial nets, LED lighting is per table(1240 lux). Floor to ceiling is approximately 3 metres and floor to lighting height is approximately 2.7 metres. The Floor in the hall is wood. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. Court sizes will be 9m x 4.5m minimum, with barriers surrounding each court.
- 12. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the Referee.
- 13. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 14. Competitors will be expected to umpire group matches
- 15. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/
- 16. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. - 18. Entry closing date Friday 3rd of May 2024 5pm. Draw will be made on Monday 6th of May 2024. Draw sent by Thursday 9th of May 2024.
- 19. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 20. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form.
- 21. All competitors will be required to sign in upon their arrival, should not leave the centre without notifying the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
- 22. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 23. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website or requested from the organiser.
- 24. Changing facilities will be available. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
- 25. Refreshments (tea/coffee/water, etc) and light snacks will be on sale (chocolate/crisps etc)
- 26. Car Park: An access code can be provided upon request for free parking. Street parking is also available (at owner's risk)
