

Table Tennis England Selection Policy

v1.0

European Youth Championship, Malmo Sweden 12th -21st July 2024

1. Event Purpose

Table Tennis England will select players to this event in order to achieve the following objectives:

- 1.1 To reach the Quarter Final or beyond in the team event
- 1.2 To reach the Quarter Final or beyond in the singles or doubles
- 1.3 Support the development of young players with a rising international profile.

2. Eligibility

Table Tennis England will only select athletes to represent England who:

- 2.1 Are affiliated to Table Tennis England, holding a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence and in good standing;
- 2.2 Are eligible to represent England in ITTF, and ETTU approved competitions and have a valid British Passport;
- 2.3 Are not currently under disqualification or suspension under the rules of Table Tennis England or ITTF & ETTU;
- 2.4 Are not currently serving any sanction for an anti-doping rule violation under any relevant anti-doping rules;
- 2.5 Have notified Table Tennis England that they wish to be considered for this event **by 9am 28th February 2024**. Players are required to notify the Performance Department in writing or by email (performance@tabletennisengland.co.uk), that they wish to be considered for selection by this date.
- 2.6 Are eligible to compete in either the Cadet and/or Junior categories. For the avoidance of doubt, players need to have been born on or after the following dates:
 - Cadet - born on or after 1st January 2009
 - Junior - born on or after 1st January 2005

3. Scope of the Team

Table Tennis England may select up to the number of players authorised by the ETTU in the following order;

3.1 Team Competition

3.1.1 The selection panel may select a team to represent England at this event up to the maximum team size (Cadet = 3, Junior = 4);

3.2 Singles Competition

3.2.1 The selection panel may select up to the number of players authorised by the ETTU to represent England in this event;

3.2.2 Players selected for the team competition will be given a singles competition entry.

3.3 Doubles & Mixed Doubles Competitions

3.3.1 The selection panel may select up to the number of pairs authorised by the ETTU to represent England in the doubles and mixed doubles events;

3.3.2 Players selected for the team competition will be given a doubles and mixed doubles competition entry.

4. Selection Criteria

The selection panel will use their expert judgement to select players for this event using the selection criteria set out below.

Primary Criteria

- International profile based on best results at both European and WTT events.
- International Ranking Trajectory in relevant age category
- Attendance levels at England and GB dates
- Positive display and commitment to performance behaviours
- Physical readiness and capability to compete at this level.
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Secondary Criteria

- Domestic results including National Championships, National Cup and 4*events (2023-24 season)
- Current national champion in relevant age category
- Team commitment and cohesion
- Engagement with pathway education programmes

5. Medical

At the time of their selection, any selected player may have their medical and/or musculoskeletal status confirmed by a nominated Table Tennis England Medical adviser. Any selected player may, at any time, be required by the Head of

Performance Development (and/or his delegate) to undergo fitness or medical assessments to ensure that they have maintained an adequate level of fitness to achieve our event purpose.

The Head of Performance Development (and/or his delegate) will specify the process by which a selected player is to confirm his or her continued health and fitness, which might include participating in certain events or undergoing fitness tests.

7. Selection Panel

A selection panel will be established comprising:

- a) Table Tennis England Head of Performance Development
- b) Table Tennis England Head of Pathway Development (non-voting)
- c) 2 x Table Tennis England Pathway Coach
- d) Independent Observer (non-voting).

In the event of any conflict of interest for any member, the Table Tennis England conflict of interest policy should be adhered to. Any member with a conflict of interest shall not be entitled to vote on that issue.

8. Team Travel, Supervision & Kit

All selected athletes will be under the supervision of Table Tennis England staff for the duration of the event. In signing this selection policy, players are committing to travelling to and from the event with the team and stay together in the accommodation arranged for the event. England Kit will be issued to all athletes for this event.

9. Media & Communication

All selected players are required to adhere to the Social Media guidance which can be found on the Table Tennis England website at the following address:

All players, whether selected or not are required to keep the notification of their selection or non-selection confidential until directed by Table Tennis England.

10. De-Selection

Table Tennis England retains the right to deselect any selected player under any of the following circumstances:

- i. The player is no longer eligible for selection for this event;
- ii. The player does not adhere to the code of conduct or team members agreement;
- iii. The player in the opinion of the Selection Panel, is no longer physically or mentally able to perform at the level consistent with that which earned their initial selection;
- iv. The player fails to comply with any reasonable training or competition programme set out by Table Tennis England performance staff;
- v. Any exceptional circumstances exist which in the reasonable opinion of the Selection Panel justify the non-selection or de-selection of the player concerned.

Any player who is de-selected will immediately be notified of the decision and the reason. They will have a right of appeal in accordance with the appeals process.

11. Appeals

Eligible players only have the right to appeal in the following cases:

- i. The criteria was not applied correctly;
- ii. A player was de-selected under Point 10 above;
- iii. An ineligible player was selected under any point.

No appeals will be considered in the following cases:

- i. Selections save for ineligibility;

For any Under 18 players', a parent or guardian will also be required to sign the returned copy. Players' should retain the second copy for their own records.
