- 5. Closing date for entries: Sunday, 1st June 2025.
- 6. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 7. Unless vacancies exist, no entry will be accepted after the draw has been made.
- 8. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- 9. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to this tournament.
- 10. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Part A or B, or in this form.
- 11. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 12. Competitions with less than 8 players will be competed on a round-robin basis. Those with 8 or more players will be contested on a group and knockout basis. Where possible, competitions will be single gender. Minimum of five entrants required otherwise age group will be played as Mixed.
- 13. Matches will be played up to five games.
- 14. Player qualification for each age group will be based on the following criteria: player's date of birth during or after the following years; under-11 (2014), under-13 (2012), under-15 (2010), under-19 (2006).
- 15. Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball. Due to the walls being of a light colour players will be offered the choice of white or orange match balls.
- 16. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.

- 17. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
- 18. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 19. The tables for the competition will be Joola Duomat $x \ 8$.
- 20. Nets and posts will be Joola WM.
- 21. Balls: Nittaku Nexcel 40+ 3* (Orange), Nittaku Premium 40+ 3* (White).
- 22. Courts: 10m x 5m, minimum height to ceiling and lights 6m.
- 23. Lighting: general LED, 300 lux.
- 24. Floor: Granwood, a cement/wood composite.
- 25. Score indicators will be used for all matches.
- 26. If possible, arrangements will be made for a separate practice hall. This is not attached to the Competition Hall so players will need to be aware of match timings. The practice area will not be similar to the Competition Hall.
- 27. Changing facilities combined with toilets.
- 28. Car parking available at venue.
- 29. Catering: vending machines for hot drinks and snacks.
- 30. Medals/Trophies will be presented to Winners and Runners-up.
- 31. Photography/livestreaming: Hastings & District Table Tennis Association may be taking photographs and live streaming matches during the event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications.
