TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One-Time Tournament Top-Up fee via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ It is not possible to obtain the OTTT at the tournament.
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4. Players will be expected to umpire group matches.
- 5. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations
- 6. All matches will be the best of 5 games. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis, with the exception of the preliminary rounds in all singles events, which will be in groups of four for men and women (At the Referee's discretion, banded singles events may be played in groups of three) with the first two players qualifying. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions except that where a player concedes a match he/she shall receive -3 group points (x).
- 7. Entries for Veterans event must have been born on or before 31st December 1984. Entries for the U21 event must have been born on or after 1st January 2004. Entries for the Restricted event must have been born between1st January 1985 and 31st December 2003 inclusive.
- 8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. Markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent. ITTF 3.2.2.5.

- 9. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
- 10. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
- 12. All competitors must report to the control table on arrival and must not leave the venue without first obtaining permission from the Referee.
- 13. Entry to banded event is restricted to players rating, according to the Table Tennis England Ratings List current at the closing date for entries. Restrictions are as follows:

 Men's Band 1: 1501 - 3000
 Women's Band 1: 1101 - 2400

 Men's Band 2: 1301 - 1500
 Women's Band 2: 701 - 1100

 Men's Band 3: 1101 - 1300
 Women's Band 3: 501 - 700

 Men's Band 4: 701 - 1100
 Women's Band 4: Up to 500

Men's Band 5: 501 – 700 Men's Band 6: up to 500

Players may enter their own band and/or the one above. The organising committee reserves the right to give dummy ratings to any entrant who does not appear on the current Table Tennis England Ratings list. (Dummy ratings are for tournament purposes only, players will have zero points on the ratings list unless they are in the top 30% of the ITTF World Ranking List).

Banded Events – If you do not have a Table Tennis England Rating, in most cases you will qualify for Band 6 (Men), Band 4 (Women). Remember, you are entitled to play in your own Band and/or the one above.

- 14. Should there be insufficient entries in any event, the Referee reserves the right to cancel/merge such event and/or place the entrants in a similar event.
- 15. The use of rackets prepared with glue containing VOCs will not be allowed.
- 16. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law on any question arising not provided for in these regulations or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Entry form All entries must be sent to the tournament secretary, Brenda Stephenson, brenda_stephenson@hotmail.com by the closing date, 14 April 2025.
- 2. Entries Entry forms shall be submitted with full payment of fees. However, the Referee may accept entries without payment at his/ discretion, but such entries will be subject to a £2 surcharge on the day. They will also be regarded as 'last received' under the 'last in first out' rule when entries have to be discarded due to over subscription.
- 3. Playing conditions Play throughout will be on 16 Butterfly Europa ITTF tables (Blue), nets and posts with Butterfly R40+ balls. Individual court size 10m x 5mm minimum enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. Sprung Wood Floor, LED Lighting (800 lux), Minimum Height of Playing Area 13m, Minimum Height of Lighting 5m,
- 4. Parking Facilities at Middlesbrough Sports Village offer excellent parking free of charge in the area immediately outside the sports facilities.
- 5. Refreshments The Sports Village has a café open during the weekend.
- 6. Changing Facilities are available in the centre
- 7. Entries "if it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt, except that all valid entries from players ranked 1-30 in the Rating List and 1-10 in the Junior Ranking List current at the closing date, must be accepted"
- 8. Practice There are no separate practice facilities.
- 9. Admission Free to all.
- 10. Doping Doping control test may take place.
- 11. Notification Entrants will be notified of the time of their first match on each day by email.
- 12. PROGRAMME All competitors will receive a complimentary programme containing the draw, their times of play and other information
- 13. P.A. system All groups and knockout matches will be announced on the P.A. system. Players must not leave the centre without permission of the Referee. Repeat calls for a player will be limited to three per day.
- 14. Players are required to umpire other matches in their band group and to umpire the next match on the table after they have lost their match in the knock-out round, if required by the Referee to do so.
- 15. Entry fee refunds will only be issued at the discretion of the Referee and the Organising Committee. No refunds will be given after the closing date
- 16. Photo/livestreaming Cleveland County Table Tennis Association may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications. If you do not give permission to take photographs and/or video of you (or individuals for whom you are legally responsible), please contact:ar@alanransome.info.
