During this period, I experienced the effort required to take a club from a small group of recreational players, when I started to a full professional set-up, when I left, recruiting players, managing funding, membership fees, coaching, equipment, competitions, committees, creating social media accounts, sourcing sponsorship etc. Like many of you I have experienced first-hand the amazing opportunities Table Tennis offers and how important every single person is to make it all work. All of this has given me a wealth of experience as well as close relationships with the whole membership (past, present, all ages etc.) which I will leverage to ensure the best future for English Table Tennis.

I also believe that my understanding and experience of working with TTE will help drive change. Since 2020, I have held various positions on TTE committees, first on the Members' Advisory Committee (MAG) and currently on the Competitions Committee and Operational Ranking Group. In these positions I have been the voice of the membership on many high priority strategic matters incl. Club Development, Rankings, Performance, Player retention, Diversity and Inclusion etc. However, the only way to influence more and be personally accountable to drive true change the membership wants, is to now take a position on the Board.

Lastly, I believe my professional experience in Strategy Consulting at PwC and now as Head of Commercial Strategy of Virgin Media O2 is extremely relevant.
