TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One-Time Tournament Top-Up fee via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> It is not possible to obtain the OTTT at the tournament.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the Conditions of the Competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. Competitors in the U15 event must have been born in 2010 or later and in the U13 events competitors must have been born in 2012 or later. Over 15's to be born in 2009 or earlier.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games.
7. All matches will be on a round robin group basis and the final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. Markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent. ITTF 3.2.2.5.
9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
10. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
12. All competitors must report to the referee on arrival and should not leave the premises without first obtaining the referee's permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
13. Should there be insufficient entries in any group the referee reserves the right to cancel that group or merge groups.
14. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations.
15. There will be no charge for admission.
16. Hot and cold drinks, refreshments and snacks will be on sale.
17. Ormesby TTC may take photos and live stream matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications. If you do not give permission to take photographs and/or video of you (or individuals for whom you are legally responsible), please contact Mrs Brenda Stephenson (brenda_stephenson@hotmail.com). 18. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Ormesby TTC may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.

20. Table Tennis England, Ormesby TTC and the referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. 21. Entries are first come first served with each girls event having 1 group of 8.
22. Entrants can only enter 1 group event. (Note: Please ensure the entry fees cover the 2 events, the group stage and the Open event.)
23. All competitors are automatically entered in the Open event.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Additional entry forms can be obtained via post or email from the organiser.
2. The draw will take place on Monday 2nd June 2025.
3. Court sizes will be 9m x 5m, with barriers surrounding each court.
4. Playing conditions – Butterfly 40+ *** white balls, 9 Butterfly Centrefold 25 tables, Butterfly nets and posts, general LED lighting and 1000 LUX. Floor to ceiling and lighting height approximately 10m. Sprung wood floor with sports mat.
5. The practise facilities will be the match tables during the registration period.
6. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
7. Changing facilities will be available, including showers.
8. Limited car parking is available free of charge within grounds of Ormesby TTC.
9. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure entry. Fees will not be refunded 1 week prior to the closing date. Entries received without payment will not be accepted.
10. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
11. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the referee.
12. Notification – players will receive acknowledgement of entry via email if entry is via email.
13. The closing date for entry is Friday 30th May 2025.
