WV Active, Wolverhampton, 26-27 April, 2025

A very warm welcome on behalf of Table Tennis England to the 2025 Butterfly National Schools Championships.

With more than 400 young players competing across well over 1,000 matches, this weekend is one of the biggest on the table tennis calendar and no fewer than 16 national titles will be decided, across girls' and boys' competitions in four age groups.

This is a vibrant event at which both team and individual honours are contested as the players represent not only themselves but also their schools. Although ours is primarily an individual sport, the team element adds a fantastic element as players support each other in their quest for shared goals.

This year is particularly historic as it is the 50th staging of the individual competition, which began in 1974 (missing two years during the pandemic). This programme includes reflections on the five decades of the competition, including from some of the previous champions who have gone on to achieve great things in the sport.

Current national singles champions Tin-Tin Ho and Liam Pitchford are among previous schools champions, as are Olympians Paul Drinkhall, Sam Walker, Kelly Sibley, Andrew Baggaley and Matthew Syed. Perhaps someone competing this weekend will follow in those illustrious footsteps!

I would like to thank the staff at WV Active for making us so welcome, our Table Tennis England staff and members of the Schools Committee, our sponsors Butterfly and, particularly, to all the volunteers who give their time to help this event run so smoothly. We are, as ever, very grateful for their dedication to our sport.

Finally, good luck to all of the players. You have already worked very hard to earn your place here and I hope you all play well, respect your opponents and, above all, enjoy the experience.

Celebrating 50 years of the Schools' Individual Championships, by John Arnold MBE

Back in the early 1960s, the English Table Tennis Association (ETTA) embarked on an intensive campaign to spread and increase interest in the game of table tennis in schools throughout the country. In some areas, school competitions already existed, in others, there was virtually no activity. A drive to establish a national structure was needed.

With support from 60 Education Authorities who organised qualifying events, Jack Carrington in his role as ETTA Director of Coaching established regional play-off finals, with the winning boys' and girls' teams competing in the inaugural National Finals in 1967. Teams were of four players aged Under-17 years.

On the occasion of the second National Finals of the School Team Championships for Under-15 and Under-17 boys and girls, held in May 1968, the first AGM of the English Schools' Table Tennis Association was held. ESTTA was born!

By 1970, competitions were held for Under-19, 16, 13 and 11 teams. The Association grew from strength to strength, not only in the number of entries but in the quality of play and presentation of events.

In 1974 the first ESTTA Individual Championships were held. This event was admirably supported by the 51 County Schools' Secretaries who organised County Qualifying rounds. Thanks should be recorded to members of the ESTTA Executive and friends for their time, given freely, to manage the above event.

As we celebrate the 50th Individual Championships, we can look back to the results of the first Championships held at the Northwood Sports Centre, Stoke on Trent on 26 May 1974.

THE INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

We have a group system of play and TWO from each group go through to the knockout stages. There is no consolation event. We cannot announce every match as it would mean almost constant use of the public address system.

Your matches as shown in the programme will be under the strict direction of your table controllers. Hence you must stay in constant contact with them. If you are not available to play when you are called you will automatically be scratched from that match. Your co-operation is needed as we have over 800 matches to play today!!

The system for deciding the final positions in each group is calculated as per ITTF Regulations for International Competitions 3.07.05

(For each match in a group, 2 match points will be awarded for a win, 1 match point for a loss in a played match and 0 match points for a loss in an unplayed or unfinished match.

The ranking order shall be determined primarily by the number of match points gained.

If two or more members of the group have gained the same number of match points their relative positions shall be determined by the results only of the matches between those being equal, taking successively the ratio of wins to losses in games and points).

All group matches will be played on tables within a designated block. All players will be given a schedule of their matches and umpiring responsibilities. Be sure to be present at the correct table.

No player, regardless of age, will be allowed to buy or consume alcoholic drinks on the premises during the Championships.
