- 2. The Draw will be held on Tuesday 10th February 2026.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. Late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the appropriate event after the closing date. If insufficient entries are received in any gender category that make the event non-viable, the Referee reserves the right to merge those categories into a mixed event.
- 4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing date (or immediately for late entries). Account Name: Ashford Table Tennis Club, Sort code: 40-08-42 Account No: 21212273, banking reference: FebT Player's Name.
- 5. There will be a strict surcharge of £5 for those who enter and/or pay late or come for a scratch entry on the day.
- 6. The sportsclub has a bar will be open for drinks and bar snacks but competitors are advised to bring a packed lunch.
- 7. Doublefish 3-star white balls will be used.
- 8. Play will take place on up to seven Donic tables with Donic nets and posts and scoring machines.
- 9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum height to lights: 14ft; Minimum Court Size: 9m X 4.5m.
- 10. Lighting is over-table LED and fluorescent lighting giving 400 lux per table. Minimum height of lights: 14ft.
- 11. The venue has wooden sprung flooring.
- 12. There is ample free parking.
- 13. There will be no admission charge.
- 14. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within two days of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out at least four days before the event. If you don't receive either, please get in touch with the tournament organisers at *clubspark.ashfordttc@gmail.com*.
- 15. No refunds or transfers are to be given after one week before the closing date under any circumstances.
- 16. The planned format for all events is to start with groups of four players with all players progressing to a knockout stage. In all events, after the initial group stage, the top two players go into the main draw knock-out & the remaining player(s) go into the consolation draw knock-out. For events with fewer than six players, the format will be round robin (all play all). The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee in light of entries received. Players looking for late entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day without informing the referee, while allowed, is not recommended.
- 17. There will be certificates for the winners & runners-up in the main draw of each event and for consolation event winners.
- 18. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
- 19. Entrants may play 1 or 2 events. If playing in 2, it must be 1 morning event & 1 afternoon event. See page 1 for the schedule.
- 20. Players will automatically be placed in their own age group events and/or the one above, depending on whether they are playing morning/afternoon/both. Any players wanting to play in an older age group than their own (and/or one above) will need to ranked in the top 20 of their own age group in England ratings to do so.
- 21. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

- 1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- 4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
- 6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low, including merging of gender categories. No refunds or transfers will be offered should merging occur.
- 8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
- 9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 10. Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball.
- 11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
- 13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
- 15. Competitors must have been born in 2014 or later for the Under 12s, 2013 or later for the Under 13s, 2011 or later for the Under 15s, 2009 or later for the Under 17s.
