#### **COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP RECORDS**

- Yorkshire's 6 divisional titles in a season (2024-25) is a new record for any county.
- Yorkshire won 5 divisional titles in 2016-17, no other county has won more than 4 divisional titles in a season.
- Yorkshire and Middlesex have each won 116 divisional titles since 1947, followed by Essex with 111.
- Yorkshire won all 4 possible divisional titles in 1972-73 and 1973-74 (Senior Premier, Senior 2 North, Junior Premier, Junior 2 North).
- Yorkshire won the Senior Premier Division for the 1st time in 1966-67 represented by Denis Neale, Mike Symonds, Peter Duncombe, Alan Hydes, Lesley Proudlock and Cynthia Duncombe.
- Yorkshire won the Junior Premier Division for the first time in 1972-73 represented by David Alderson, Robert Wiley, Brian Alderson, Philip Ward, Judith Walker, Pat Clements, Karen Wilson, Melody Ludi and Julie Mclean.
- Yorkshire won the Veteran Premier Division for the first time in 1990-91 represented by Denis Neale, Malcolm Corking, Derek Munt, Pat Bassano and Carol Judson.
- Yorkshire won the Over 60 Premier Division for the first time in 2012-13 represented by Doug Bartle, Steve Kosmowsky, Freddie Yeung and Sandra Rider.
- Yorkshire won the Cadet Premier Division for the first time in 2013-14 represented by James Hobson, James Rule, Shayan Siraj, Harry Dai, Kate Nixon and Gauri Duhan.
- Yorkshire and Sussex are the only counties to have won the 5 Premier Divisions (Senior, Junior, Cadet, Veteran and Over 60).
- Yorkshire have won the Senior Premier Division 7 times; Denis Neale (1966-67, 1972-73, 1973-74), Peter Marshall, Michael James and Joanna Roberts (1997-98, 2000-01, 2001-02) played in the successful team on 3 occasions.
- Yorkshire have won more Junior Premier Division titles (16) and more Junior Divisions overall (44) than any other county.
- LA (Tony) Clayton, Raymond Hinchliff, Kathleen Best, Brian Kennedy, Denis Neale, Melody Ludi, Alan Fletcher and Alan Hydes are the most 'capped' Yorkshire Senior team players.
