## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by email by Ly Tuubel by no later than **Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2025**
2. The Draw will be held on **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February** and will be available on the day not beforehand
3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing date (or immediately for late entries).

6. The Limpsfield club has a bar offering hot and cold drinks and food. Free car parks, toilets, changing rooms and shower facilities are available at the venue.
7. Butterfly R40+ White balls will be used.
8. Play will take place on 4 Butterfly Tables with Joola/Butterfly nets and scoring boards.
9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 7m; Minimum Court Size: 8m x 4m
10. Lighting is general & LED over each table Minimum height of lighting: 7m.
11. The venue has wooden sprung flooring.
12. There will be no admission charge.
13. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 3 days of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 5 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with Ly Tuubel
14. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances
15. The events are: **U15's (born in 2011 or later), U17's (born in 2009 or later), U19 (born in 2007 or later) mixed singles**
16. Winner and Runners Up in each main event category will receive trophies or medals/certificates
17. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
18. Format will be 4 groups of 4. The top 2 in each group going forward to play in a knockout and 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> player in groups go forward to play knockout consolation.
19. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.

## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.
8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Please speak with the referee if you think you need permission for other attire. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. Markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent. ITTF 3.2.2.5"
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
13. No time outs are allowed.
14. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
15. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme
16. Photos may be taken on behalf of The Limpsfield Club photos during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, and press releases and funding applications.
