### **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS** (to be retained)

- 1 Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <a href="https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/">https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/</a> once this product is launched. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One- Time Tournament Top-Up fee via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. Players may be expected to umpire group matches.
- 6. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final

order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.

7. Competitors in Junior events must have been born in 2007 or later. Competitors in Under 17 events must be born in 2009 or later.

Competitors in Cadet events must have been born in 2011 or later.

- Competitors in Under 13 events must have been born in 2013 or later. 8. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part
- sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended.
- 9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
- 11. All competitors must report to the Booking In/ Control Desk on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 12. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event. There will be no consolation or plate events at this tournament.
- 13. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.
- 14. Racket testing may take place.
- 15. No refunds will be given after the closing date and a fee of £10 per entry may also be charged for any late entries.
- 16. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 17. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see
- 18. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. For further details, please see the Table Tennis England Workforce Protection Policy.

#### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Entry Form Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to Cathy Steeples, no later than **Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2025**. Entries without fees will not be accepted. Entries should be sent to <a href="mailto:cmsteeples@hotmail.com">cmsteeples@hotmail.com</a> with the player's name being used as the reference (BACS details are on the entry form itself).
- 2. Draw The draw will take place on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 11 Ward Drive, St Neots, CAMBS, PE19 0AP.
- 3. Admission There will be no charge for admission.
- 4. Playing Conditions Play throughout will be on 18 Joola tables & nets, <u>Joola Flash 3\* seamless white plastic balls</u>, wooden sprung floor and general LED lighting a minimum of 5m above the table. Court size will be 10m x 5m enclosed by surrounds. Joola scoring machines will be used for all matches.
- 5. Doping Doping control tests may take place.
- 6. Practice There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.
- 7. Car Parking Free car parking (at owner's risk) is available at the venue.
- 8. Changing facilities (men's, women's and disabled) and showers are available.
- 9. Refreshments Light refreshments will be on sale.
- 10. Prizes Trophies will be awarded to all Winners & Runners Up.
- 11. Notification Once completed, and before the date of the tournament, the draw will be emailed out to players, to include the timings for group matches by the Referee.

#### **Junior 4\* Tournaments – Entry Qualifications**

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt, except that all valid entries from the top 50 TTE ranked males and top 30 TTE ranked females in the event age-group will be accepted.

• 14-15 Feb: Plymouth 4\*

07-08 Mar: Cadet & U17s National Champs

 Junior National Championships invites based on March ranking run (Published 11 March) – eligibility play 2 of 6

16-17 May: Junior & U21 National Champs

Invitations will be issued on the following basis:

- 1. All invitees to Cadet National Championships and Junior National Championships 2026 must participate in at least 2x designated 4\* events, notwithstanding mitigating circumstances
- 2. Invitations will be issued to 20 from ranking list + 10 qualifying from 4\* events + 2 wildcards (that will default to qualifiers if unused)
- 3. All boy's and girl's Cadet and Junior 4\* winners will receive an automatic invitation if they meet the 2x 4\* entry requirement
- 4. Thereafter, qualifiers determined by 'leader-board' approach; no points (except those for entering) are available for consolation events

o Enter: 1 point

o Main QF: +1 point (2 total)

o Main SF: +1 point (3 total)

o Main R/up: +1 point (4 total)

o Main Winner: +2 points (5 total; automatic qualification)

Please note that eligibility/ qualifying invites/ leaderboard for Cadet National Championships will include Chandlers 4\*, but event results will not be reflected in the national rankings until February.
