TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED **by email** by Brett Holt by no later than Friday, 9th January 2026. Please only send page 4, not the whole document. You can download free program Adobe Adolix Split & Merge to split pdfs into individual pages. If you'd prefer a copy of the entry form in Word format, please contact Brett Holt on brettholtuk@gmail.com.
- 2. The Draw will be held on Tuesday, 20th January 2026.
- 3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt. Late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the appropriate event after the closing date.
- 4. Payment must be made **by bank transfer** by the closing date (or immediately for late entries).

- 5. There will be a strict surcharge of £5 for those who enter and/or pay late or come for a scratch entry on the day.
- 6. There may be light refreshments available for purchase from the Organising Committee on the day and there is a café at the venue.
- 7. ANDRO ZeroT 40+ 3-star white balls will be used.
- 8. Play will take place on 8 or more Andro & Donic tables with Butterfly nets and posts and with Butterfly scoring machines.
- 9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 7m; Minimum Court Size: 9m X 4.5m.
- 10. Lighting is general & fluorescent lighting. The minimum light intensity is 300 lux. Minimum height of lights: 7m.
- 11. The venue has wooden sprung flooring.
- 12. There is ample free parking. There are both changing rooms and shower facilities.
- 13. There will be no admission charge.
- 14. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 day of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out at least 4 days before the event. If you don't receive both, please get in touch with Brett.
- 15. No refunds or transfers are to be given after the closing date under any circumstances.
- 16. The planned format for all events is to start with groups of 3 or 4 players with all players progressing to a knockout stage. In all events, after the initial group stage, the top 2 players go into the main draw knock-out & the remaining player(s) go into the consolation draw knock-out. Events with 4 or 5 entries will be played in a Round Robin format (all play all in a group). Girl's & Boy's events will be merged if there are less than 4 players in an event. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee in light of entries received. Players looking for late entries should inform the Referee in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day without informing the Referee, while allowed, is not recommended.
- 17. There will be medals for the winners & runners-up in the main draw of each event, or alternatively finalists can choose a pair of table tennis sports socks or a 3-ball holder instead of a medal.
- 18. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
- 19. Entrants may play 1 or 2 events. If playing in 2, it must be 1 morning event & 1 afternoon event. See page 1 for the schedule.
- 20. Players will automatically be placed in their own age group & gender events and/or the age group above, depending on whether they are playing morning/afternoon/both. Any players wanting to play in an older age group than their own (and/or one above) will need to be ranked in the top 30 of their own age group in Table Tennis England ratings to do so.
- 21. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary.

 Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
- 22. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. See here
- 23. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. For further details, please see the Table Tennis England Workforce Protection Policy
- 24. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

- 1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
- 3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ once this product is launched. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One- Time Tournament Top-Up fee via https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/ It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
- 4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
- 6. Competitors must report to the Referee on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 7. The Referee reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low. No refunds or transfers will be offered should merging occur. Girl's & Boy's events will be merged if there are less than 4 players in an event.
- 8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of the Referee.
- 9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. Any markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent.
- 11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
- 12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
- 13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
- 15. Competitors must have been born in 2015 or later for Under 11s, 2014 or later for Under 12s, 2012 or later for Under 14s, 2011 or later for Under 15s, 2008 or later for Under 18s and 2007 or later for Under 19s. All age groups will have separate male and female categories.
