## **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

- 1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <a href="https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/">https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/</a> once this product is launched. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the fournament
- 2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
- 3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B. or in this form
- 4. The competition is open to a maximum of 84 players, and group sizes based on entrants, groups may be mixed between male/female if there are not sufficient entrants.
- 5. All events will be based on the Table Tennis England ranking list effective on the closing date for entries. The organiser reserves the right to place any unranked players in the grade(s) he feels appropriate. All events will be seeded. All matches will be the best of 5 games.
- 6. Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball.
- 7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- 8. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- 9. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
- 10. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
- 11. All Competitors must report to the Booking-In Control on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 12. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
- 13. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- 14. If insufficient entries are received in any gender category that make the event non-viable, the Referee reserves the right to merge those categories into a mixed event.

## **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

- 1: If the Tournament is oversubscribed (max 84 entrants), and it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
- 2: The last day for receipt of entries is 17<sup>h</sup> May 2026. The draw will take place on 22 May 2026.
- 3: Each entrant will receive an acknowledgement of entry by Email.
- 4: There will be no charge for admission to the venue.
- 5: Play throughout will be with ITTF 3\* DHS D40+ Plastic balls. 10 12 Sponneta tables will be used in courts measuring approximately 9m x 4.7m; with Lion nets and posts; with Stiga barriers surrounding most of the Court. Overhead general strip lighting averaging above 1500 Lumens, and minimum height of the playing area is above 10m. Flooring is wooden and sprung.
- 6: Score indicators will be used on some (but not all tables).
- 7: The size of each group will be at the organisers discretion, and players will be placed into groups based on Table Tennis England rating system and previous results and at the Organisers discretion. All players will play each other, and the outcome of each group will be decided by the results of all those matches. The maximum group size will be 8. In the event of a 2-player tie, the head-to-head rule applies. In the event of a tie between more than 2 players, the places will be determined by game ratio and then point ratio.
- 8: Each match will be controlled by an umpire, whose decision will be final on all matters of fact.
- 9: No practice tables will be available. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not currently in use at the discretion of the Organiser.
- 10: Free car parking is available at the Centre.
- 11: Changing facilities including hot showers are available at the Centre.
- 12. Hot & cold meals will be available 9am-7pm from the on-site Café.
- 13: All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary.
