

Tournament Regulations

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Preliminary matches will be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
7. Players' Clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball.
8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
9. Doping shall not take place either before or during play, doping control tests may take place.
10. All Competitors must report to the Booking-In Control on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
11. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
12. Players must have been born in, 1985 or earlier for the Veterans events and 2005 or later for the under 21 events. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
13. Competitors may enter three events subject to eligibility (Age category, open singles and prize event).
14. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
15. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
16. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. See [here](#)
17. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. For further details, please see the Table Tennis England [Workforce Protection Policy](#)
18. System of play: All events will be played in groups, followed by knockout rounds to a final. The top two players in the group will progress with all remaining players qualifying for the Plate event, except in the Prize event where all players progress according to their group position.
19. Prizes: Trophies or medals will be presented to all winners and runners up in both main events and plate events.
20. Prize event: 100% of the £15 entry fee in THIS event will go into the prize fund. All group winners will go into Pool A and play for 50% of the entire prize fund. All group runners up will go into Pool B and play for 30% of the entire prize fund. All third placed players will go into Pool C and play for 20% of the entire prize fund. Players in a group and all are guaranteed to progress into the knockout stage.

Entries – If it is necessary to restrict entries the last to be received will be rejected. Once the draw is made no refunds will be made. The draw will be made on Monday 12th January 2026.

Playing conditions –

Courts: Each table is in an individual court enclosed by surrounds Court sizes are 9m x 4.5m Minimum height of playing area (floor to ceiling) 8m Minimum height of lighting from floor 7m.

Lighting: The venue has general LED lighting.

Floor: The floor is comprised of brick blocks.

Play will be on 8 Sponeta tables with Sponeta nets and posts. Balls will be Butterfly 3 Star 40+ white. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.

Car Parking: There is plenty of free parking at the venue.

Admission: There is no admission charge to the venue for players or spectators.

Refreshments – There will be light refreshments and drinks available throughout the day.

Showers – There are shower and changing facilities available.

Practice – There are no separate practice facilities, but practice is allowed on free tables at the Referee's discretion.

Ranking Scheme – All match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England Computer Ranking Scheme.

Prizes – Prizes: Trophies or medals will be presented to all winners and runners up in both main events and plate events.

PA System – Matches will be announced on the PA system. Players should stay within the centre when they are due to play.

Accommodation – There is a huge choice of places to stay in Scarborough. Advice can be given upon request.
