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## TABLE TENNIS FOR ALL TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to [jwramage1@gmail.com](mailto:jwramage1@gmail.com) by the closing date. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment WILL NOT be entered.
2. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt, except that all valid entries from the top 50 TTE ranked males and top 30 TTE ranked females in the event age-group will be accepted.
3. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website.
4. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
5. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. See [here](#).
6. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. For further details, please see the Table Tennis England [Workforce Protection Policy](#)
7. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
8. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
9. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One- Time Tournament Top-Up fee via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament
10. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. Players will be expected to umpire group matches. The top 2 players from each group will progress into KO stages
11. Players' Clothing:2-Star & above: as specified in TTE regulations Part A. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. Any markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent.

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12. Photo/livestreaming Nottingham Table Tennis Club may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications. If you do not give permission to take photographs and/or video of you (or individuals for whom you are legally responsible), please contact (organisation email) Please be aware that we follow the Table Tennis England's [Photo and live streaming Policy](#)
13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
14. Playing conditions - there will be 21 tables in total, Butterfly, Donic and Sponeta tables, Butterfly and Donic nets and post, Sanwei 3\* white balls, LED lighting is general and 750 lux. Floor to ceiling height is over 5 metres, wooden floor, scoring machines will be used for all matches, court sizes will be 9m x 4.5m, with barriers surrounding each court. There will be 4 show courts sized 10m x 5m.
15. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the Referee.
16. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form.
17. Doping shall not take place either before or during play; and doping control tests may take place.
18. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival, should not leave the centre without notifying the referee.
19. PA System - all matches will be announced on the PA system, players must not leave the centre without permission of the referee, repeat calls for a player will be limited to 3 per day. Players absent after the 3<sup>rd</sup> call **WILL** be scratched from their next match.
20. Practice will only be permitted prior to event starting.
21. The tournament is included in the Computer Ranking Scheme.
22. Changing facilities will be available, including showers.
23. Car Parking is available free of charge and a small walk across campus to venue, access details will be sent with the draw confirmation.
24. Player Number - a £10 deposit is included on the entry form, this will be refunded when the referee is satisfied that the player has carried out umpiring duties where required (umpire a match per category entered, it will be for both days). Please note players will be required to complete a short refund form to gain their refund, this must be completed on the day of the competition to gain their player deposit refund, player deposit refunds will not be paid after the event.
25. All participants may be allocated a number for the competition; however, no player numbers will be provided, and they are not required to be worn at the competition.
26. Refreshments, light snacks will be available in the vending machines at the Sports Centre, in addition there will be a Costa open until 8am-4pm both days, which is located a short walk across campus
27. Entry to the U21 event, players should be born after 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004.
28. Entry to the restricted event players should be born between 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004 inclusive.
29. Entry to the Veterans event players should born prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986.
30. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
31. Refunds for entries will only be issued 1 week prior to the closing date, minus £10 admin charge.

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## TABLE TENNIS FOR ALL CATEGORIES AND ENTRY FEES

Players can compete in the below categories over the weekend, with the 1<sup>st</sup> event costing £50 of which £10 of this is a player deposit which is refundable (subject to Regulation 24 above). Each additional category that is entered will be £13 per event.

### ENTRY BANDED EVENTS

Entry to the banded events will be restricted by player's ratings, according to the Table Tennis England Ratings list current at the closing date for entries, the organizing committee reserves the right to give dummy ratings to any entrant who does not appear on the current TTE ratings list. Restrictions are as follows:
