If there are insufficient entries in any gender category to form a group of 7, then groups will be mixed.

Regulations

Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament

TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.

ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.

All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.

System of play: The event will consist of groups of 7 or 8 players, which may be mixed sex if insufficient numbers to run separate events.

Groups will be drawn based on current rankings and/or at the organisers discretion.

Each match will be the best of 5 games

All players must have been born in 1985 or earlier.

Players' Clothing:

Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball.

No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.

Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.

Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.

Playing Conditions and Equipment

Tables: 7 x Butterfly Octet

Nets and posts: Butterfly

Balls: White Butterfly R40 3 star ITTF

Court sizes will be 9m x 4.5 m with barriers surrounding each court.

Lighting is state of the art LED at least 750 lux at approximately 6 metres. Flooring is Gerfloor

Score indicators: Will be used on all tables for all matches

Information Section

Practice: There are no practice facilities available once the event starts.

Changing facilities .There are men's, ladies and disabled toilets, showers and changing rooms.
