Tournament Format: Format will be banded (on ability) with each band consisting of 2 ratings groups of 6, the top 2 from each group will progress to the semi-final stage. So, if there is a full entry of players, each player is guaranteed 5 matches.

The winners and runners-up of Senior band 1 will receive £150 and £75, Senior band 2 winners and runners-up will receive £75 and £30. The winners and runners-up of Senior bands 3,4, and all Junior and Cadet bands will be presented with trophies and medals.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by email to Aaron Shaheed by no later than **Wednesday 3rd June 2026**
2. The Draw will be held on **Thursday 4th June** and will be available on Thursday 4th June
3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing date (or immediately for late entries).
5. Account Name: online **Match Point TT Events**, SC: 82-19-74 Account: 40051808 Banking Reference: Player's Full Name and tournament date.
6. Free car parks, toilets, changing rooms and shower facilities are available at the venue.
7. A selection of hot and cold drinks and snacks will be available to purchase at the venue.
8. DHS WTT 3* White balls will be used.
9. Play will take place on 6 Butterfly Centerfold 25 Tables with Butterfly Nets and Posts, and with Butterfly Scoring Machines
10. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 3.6m; Minimum Court Size: 9m x 5m
11. Lighting is over each table. Minimum height of lighting: 3.6m.
12. The venue has sprung wooden flooring, covered by Taraflex flooring.
13. There will be no admission charge.
14. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 3 days of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out on the closing date of the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with Aaron Shaheed
15. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances
16. The events are: **Senior Men's morning bands, Senior Ladies morning bands, Senior Men's afternoon bands, Senior Ladies afternoon bands, Cadet Boy's morning bands, and Cadet Girl's morning bands, Junior Boy's afternoon bands, and Junior Girl's afternoon bands**
17. The winners and runners-up of Senior band 1 will receive £150 and £75, Senior band 2 winners and runners-up will receive £75 and £30. The winners and runners-up of Senior bands 3,4, and all Junior and Cadet bands will receive trophies and medals.
18. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
19. Format for all bands will be 2 groups of 6 followed by knockout. So, if full entry of players, each player is guaranteed 5 matches. The bands will be determined on ability.
20. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
21. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. See [here](#)

TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament
4. Players entering cadet events must have been born in 2011 or later, and players entering junior events must have been born in 2007 or later.
5. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
6. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
7. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
8. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.
9. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
10. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered. All competitors will be scheduled to umpire via the playing schedule group sheet.
11. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. Any markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent.
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
13. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
14. Time outs are permitted.
15. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
16. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme
17. Photo/livestreaming, Match Point Table Tennis Academy may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications.
