TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One- Time Tournament Top-Up fee via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. The competition is open to a maximum of 24/28 players in the Junior event. In the event there are insufficient male/female entrants, the organising committee reserve the right to combine the groups.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered. All players will be required to umpire as scheduled during their group matches.
6. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. ITTF 3.2.2.2 amended. Markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent. ITTF 3.2.2.5.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play; and doping control tests may take place.
9. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to brenda_stephenson@hotmail.com. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.
10. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the Referee.
11. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
12. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to TTE Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
13. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. 15. Entry closing date Saturday 13th June 2026 5pm. Draw will be Tuesday 16th June 2026.
16. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
17. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form.
18. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival, should not leave the centre without notifying the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match. Practice will only be permitted prior to event starting.
19. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
20. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website or requested from the organiser.
21. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
22. Players in the junior event must have been born in 2007 or later; and for the cadet event, players must be born in 2011 or later.
23. Refreshments (tea/coffee/water and various drinks) and light snacks will be on sale (chocolate/crisps etc)

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Additional entry forms can be obtained via post or email from the organiser.
2. The draw will take place on Tuesday 16th June 2026.
3. Court sizes will be 9m x 5m, with barriers surrounding each court.
4. Playing conditions – Butterfly 40+ *** white balls, 9 Butterfly Centrefold 25 tables, Butterfly nets and posts, general LED lighting and 1000 LUX. Floor to ceiling and lighting height approximately 10m. Sprung wood floor with sports mat.
5. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
6. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
7. Changing facilities will be available, including showers.
8. Limited car parking is available free of charge within grounds of Ormesby TTC.
9. Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure entry. Fees will not be refunded 1 week prior to the closing date. Entries received without payment will not be accepted.
10. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
11. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the referee.
12. Notification – players will receive acknowledgement of entry via email if entry is via email.
13. The closing date for entry is Sunday 13th June 2026.
