PROVISIONAL PLAYING SCHEDULE

Players will be ranked based on the latest computer rating/ranking points, based on a **1* Tournament**. 30/32 max entries only.

No restriction on gender (separate gender groups will run if enough entries) based on a **1* Tournament**.

Groups of 4 with a round robin per group followed by a knock-out. The winner and runner-up of each group will go to the main draw. Position 3 and 4 will go to the consolation event. Groups will be mixed if there are not enough male/female players in each category.

The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments communicated by email.

Registration and practice from 8:00am, with play to commence at 8:30am.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. The competition is open to a maximum of 16 players per category. In the event there are insufficient male/female entrants, the organising committee reserve the right to combine the groups.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered and as scheduled during their group matches.
6. Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
9. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations, and must be sent to freethorpe1989@gmail.com . Full payment at point of entry will be required to secure your entry. Entries received with no payment will not be entered.
10. Playing conditions - Butterfly R40+ 3* white, 4 Tibhar Smash 28r, Tibhar nets and post, Suspended Luminaries lighting is general and 750 lux. Floor to ceiling and floor to lighting height is approximately 8 metres. Flooring is composite block and resin covered. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. Court sizes will be 9m x 4.5m, with barriers surrounding each court.
11. No entry will be accepted after the draw has been made, subject to the discretion of the Referee.
12. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
13. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table tennis England Codes of Conduct. See [here](#)
14. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. Photo/livestreaming Thorpe TTC may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications. 16. Entry closing date **Monday 17th August**. Draw will be made on **Tuesday 18th August**. Draw sent by **Thursday 20th August**.
17. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
18. In conjunction with the TTE Child Protection Policy, persons wishing to take photographs or video images must register with the event organiser, producing their professional identification, TTE authorisation or a completed TTE authorisation form which can be obtained from the organiser.
19. All competitors will be required to book in upon their arrival, should not leave the centre hall without notifying the referee. Players absent when due to play are liable to be scratched from their next match. Practice will only be permitted prior to event starting.
20. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
21. There will be no charge for admission. Entry forms can be downloaded from the TTE website or requested from the organiser.
22. Changing facilities will be available, including showers. Practice will only be permitted prior to the event starting.
23. Refreshments (tea/coffee/water and various drinks) and light snacks will be on sale (chocolate/crisps etc).
24. Car parking is available free of charge.
25. Entrants for the Veterans' events must have been born in 1986 or earlier.
