TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED **by email** to Claire Kelly by no later than **Monday 13th July 2026**
2. The Draw will be held on **Wednesday 22nd July 2026**. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
3. Payment must be made **by bank transfer** by the closing dates (or immediately for late entries).
4. Account Name: Waterside Table Tennis Club, Account no: 61194259, Sort Code: 40-25-24, Reference: Player's Full Name followed by 2STAR.
5. Hot and cold drinks, snacks are available on site. There is ample free parking and toilets, changing rooms and shower facilities are available at the venue
6. **White Butterfly R40+ 3 Star Balls will be used.**
7. Play will take place on up to 10 Donic Delhi 25 tables with Donic Net and post sets and Donic Scoring boards.
8. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum Court Size: 9m x 5m.
9. Lighting is general & fluorescent lighting. Minimum light intensity is 500 lux. Minimum height of lighting: 7m.
10. The venue has gran sprung flooring.
11. There will be no admission charge.
12. Competitors in U19 events must be born in 2007 or later
13. Competitors in Veteran events must be born in 1985 or earlier.
14. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 days of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 2 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with Claire Kelly.
15. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
16. The planned format is groups of 4 and players will be ranked based on the latest computer ranking list. The top 2 players in each group will go through to the main draw knockout event and the bottom 2 players will go into a consolation knockout event.
17. The organising committee reserves the right to modify the group sizes in light of entries received; any amendments to times will be communicated via email. Players looking for scratch entries should inform the Organiser in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed, is more risky.
18. Winner, Runner Up and Losing Semifinalists of the Open Singles will receive prize money and trophies. Winner and Runner up of the Veterans event will receive prize money and trophies. Open Singles Consolation Winner, Runner Up and Veterans Consolation Winner and Runner Up will receive trophies. Winner and Runner Up of the U19s event will receive trophies.
19. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
20. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
21. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. See [Here](#)

TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> once this product is launched. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One-Time Tournament Top-Up fee via <https://tabletennisengland.sport80.com/> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5
6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
7. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.
8. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.
9. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. Markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent.
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping Control tests may take place.
12. No gluing up or boosting/tuning will be allowed.
13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
15. Photo/livestreaming: Waterside Table Tennis Club and Hampshire County Table Tennis may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications.
