Entry Provisions:

1. Entries must be RECEIVED by email no later than Friday 23rd October 2026
2. The Draw will be held on Wednesday 28th October 2026
3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
4. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
5. Medals will be awarded to Band Winners and Runners-up

Tournament Regulations:

1. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
2. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://ttehub.com/>. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.
4. The Tournament is open to all ages but only one age group category may be entered each day.

Seniors - open to all players

Juniors - players must be born in 2008 or later

Cadets - players must be born in 2012 or later

The planned format is banded groups of 8 but there may be some groups of 6 or 7. Banding will be based upon the most recent TTE rating list available at the draw date with adjustments made at the referee's discretion and where practicable to minimise clashes between players of the same club/league/county. For players with no rating, banding will be based upon known ability level and or age at the referee's discretion. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. If insufficient entries are received for a particular event, the referee reserves the right to merge events.

5. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. Medals will be awarded to Band Winners and Runners-up. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.

6. If players pull out before the day we will try to find replacements. Players looking for scratch entries need to inform the Tournament Referee in advance to secure their place. Turning up on the day, while allowed is riskier.

7. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched. Players who have not reported to Control by 9.15am may be replaced.

8. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.

9. There will be no separate practice facilities, but competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of Control.

10. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.

11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping control tests may take place.

12. No gluing up or boosting will be allowed.

13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.

14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.

15. The main colour of playing clothing must be different from that of the ball in use.

16. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.

Playing Conditions and Equipment

1. Food & drink may be purchased at the venue & there is free parking. There are showers & changing room facilities.

2. Open cans/other drinks are NOT allowed in the playing hall.

3. Play will take place on up to 10 Sponeta 8-36 tables with Sponeta net and post sets. Scoring machines will be available for all matches.

4. Play will be with Nittaku premium 3 Star 40+ white balls.
5. Tables will be on Court Size: 9m X 4.5m with barriers surrounding all courts
6. Lighting is general ceiling fluorescent strip lighting of 300 lux at table height. Min floor to lighting height: 7m.
7. The venue has multi-purpose sports hall flooring with plastic surface finish on a concrete base.
8. There will be no admission charge on the day

General

1. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
