Dear Club Secretary/ Team contact,

Cadet & Junior British Clubs Leagues – season 2026/27

Please note that the [MEMBERSHIP](#) link is for individual players to buy/ update individual memberships and for clubs to create/ renew affiliations; the [REGISTRATION](#) link is for officers of affiliated clubs to manage their team entries, player registrations and playing rosters; the HOST VENUE webpages will be live when team entries are allocated to specific venues – this is where players and clubs can see their fixtures/ tables/ stats, and are also used by hosts to manage their divisions.

Please find the season details for 26/27, and kindly note the following:

1. Please note that clubs must be affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Premier, Associate or Registered Club/ Team. As of 01 August (new membership year), all Club details for each team will be validated and checked against the Table Tennis England membership database. Your entry will remain incomplete until this time, and may be rejected if not completed as required
2. Team entry, player registration and payments are **online** via the [TT Leagues](#) registration website. This functionality is accessible to designated administrators of your club, once they have logged-in. Administrators for your club can be managed via your club's profile in [TT Memberships](#). Video tutorials have been produced for the same processes which already exist in British League, and which are largely consistent with CadetBCL/ JuniorBCL:

 2. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nq_RzpKzGUIThese serve as an introduction to the entry functionality, and provide an overview of how to submit your team entries, player registrations, and make payment online.
3. Full payment of £115 per team will be required with entry
4. During entry, teams will be required to indicate if the team is mixed/boy's open or girls¹
5. During entry, teams will be required to register a minimum of 3 eligible players
6. Please see the separate note on Player Licensing below
7. Please also note that all players **must** be individually affiliated in *TT Memberships* to the Club/ Team the player wishes to represent (in the same way as for local leagues). Players will **not** be able to be registered or selected for your club in the TT Leagues platform if this is not the case. Individual players can check and update their affiliations by [logging-in to their membership](#) and

checking under 'Club & League Info'. Clubs admins can also check which players are already affiliated to their club in [TT Memberships](#)

8. During entry, teams will be required to specify their preferred geographical venue, plus their preferred alternative(s) - at least two options must be selected
9. Girls' divisions will be formed if sufficient girls team entries are received at local level, or a division can be consolidated across a region. For this reason, it is particularly important to specify alternative preferred venues during the entry process for girls teams
10. Please note that a separate and dedicated Girls' CadetBCL competition will also be run. Girl's players in Cadet/ JuniorBCL will not be restricted from the Girls' CadetBCL competition. **Entry details for the Girls' CadetBCL competition will be available later in the season.**
11. The Committee will endeavour to place all teams in an appropriate geographical playing venue, based on their indicated preferences. Clearly, given the number of teams applying from certain areas, this is not always possible. Applications for entry are therefore made in the knowledge and full acceptance that some travelling may be required.
12. Once your entry/ payment is complete, your club/ team player ranking order can also be managed via a 'drag and drop' process in the online entry system. To assist with this process, please see the following illustrative video tutorial guide: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CQUdTkVVyAM>
13. The club/ team player ranking order will always close on the Friday one week before the next round at each venue, and this will then be reopened on the Monday after that round in preparation for the next.
14. Fixtures, leagues, results and stats for Cadet & Junior British Clubs Leagues will continue to use the TT Leagues platform

Please note: ~~as per last season~~, YouthBCL players registered for YouthBCL teams are not able to play down to Cadet, and ~~Boy's Open players registered for YouthBCL teams are not able to play down to~~ JuniorBCL. Players in JuniorBCL may play-up to YouthBCL and ~~Boy's Open players~~ will become restricted to YouthBCL for the remainder of the season only at the point that they compete in 5x YouthBCL team matches (accumulatively for any club/team on any date in the season).

Please also note:

- All teams will be required to submit a 2nd venue preference as a condition of entry, and are actively encouraged to submit a 3rd venue preference, in order to maximise likelihood of entry applications being successfully placed at a host venue
- Clubs entering 10 or more teams are also required to submit a 3rd venue preference
- Entry applications for clubs' 1st-teams will always have priority. Host venues can generally expect that their own team entries up to a 50% maximum capacity will be accommodated. Non-hosts can generally expect that every effort will be made to accommodate all their teams, but please note that in some parts of the country if a club enters more than 5 teams, they must be prepared for additional teams to travel to alternative venues, and that it may not be possible to accept entries for all additional team applications.

Player Licensing:

- Please note that **all** players will require a Table Tennis England Player *Compete* membership for season 26/27 **prior** to their first fixture. New memberships start as of 01 August. However, if you are registering a player in June-July 2026 for the sole purpose of your entry, any membership category including *Club Play* will suffice for the purposes of this process
- Home Countries players (those with season 26/27 affiliations with table tennis associations in Ireland, Scotland, Wales, Jersey, Guernsey or Isle of Man) or International Players (those with season 26/27 affiliations with table tennis associations outside the home countries) will be issued a free-of-charge reciprocal registration *upon production of evidence to the TTE office*. This is the full responsibility of the player/ team concerned, and is valid only until 31 July each season

- Fixtures in which a team fields ineligible or non-registered players, or field players in the incorrect playing order, may be forfeit
