Tournament Regulations

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternately purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://ttehub.com> It is not possible to obtain the OTTP at the tournament.

2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
5. All events will be played in groups of 3 with the top 2 to qualify for the knockout stages, with the exception of the Prizefighter event.
6. All matches will be best of 5 games.
7. Players entering the Junior singles must have been born in 2008 or later.
8. Players entering the Veteran singles must have been born in 1986 or earlier.
9. Players entering the Intermediate event must have been born in the years 1986 to 2008.
10. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers including tracksuit bottoms, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. ITTF 3.2.2.1 amended. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. 3.2.2.2 amended.
11. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
13. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
14. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. Please see <https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/about-us/safeguarding/safeguarding-codes-of-conduct-and-terms-of-reference/>
15. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. 16. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
17. All players will be entered into their 3 events automatically, there is no provision to play in fewer events, all players are guaranteed a minimum of 7 matches and the tournament is limited to the first 48 entries.
18. There are cash prizes in every event

Playing Conditions:

1. Play will be on 8 Butterfly tables with Joola posts and nets.
2. Balls used will be white Decathlon Pongori C40+ 3 star poly balls.
3. Each table will be in an individual court enclosed by surrounds.
4. Each court will be 9 metres long by 4.5 metres wide.
5. Minimum height of playing area (floor to ceiling) is 5 metres.
6. Minimum height of lighting from floor is 5 metres.
7. Lighting is general LED and 500 lux.
8. Flooring is semi-sprung timber.
9. Score indicators will be used for all matches.

Tournament Information

1. Doping control tests may take place.
2. No practice facilities are available.
3. Changing room facilities are available with showers.
4. Free onsite parking is available.
5. Hot and cold refreshments will be available for purchase from our cafeteria.
6. The events will be played on the following basis:-

Prizefighter Event

Three players in each group and all group winners will go into Pool A, all group runners up go into Pool B, and all third placed go into Pool C 3, each then playing their own knockout rounds.

All other events

Played on a group basis, followed by knockout rounds.

7. Prizes

There is a total Prize Fund of a minimum of £1,200, based on 48 players ; the more players per event then the larger the prize fund.

Based on the maximum entry of 48 players.
