Regulations

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Plus Member or provide proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and pay the appropriate fee in order to gain a reciprocal membership. An entrant who is not a TTE member or is affiliated as a Supporter or Club Play Member may alternatively purchase a One-Off Tournament Pass at the time of entry via <https://ttehub.com/> once this product is launched. An entrant only affiliated as a Compete member may enter the tournament upon payment of the appropriate One-Time Tournament Top-Up fee via <https://ttehub.com/>. It is not possible to obtain the OTTP or the OTTT at the tournament.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
5. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
6. System of play: matches will be run in groups followed by knockout, or straight knockout, at the discretion of the Referee. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5 for Group competitions. The most recent TTE rating list will be used to formulate the groups.
7. Playing clothing shall consist of a shirt and shorts, trousers including tracksuit bottoms, leggings or skirt, or a one-part sports outfit, socks and playing shoes; a sports hijab may also be worn. Other garments shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee. The main colour of a shirt, shorts, trousers or skirt, other than sleeves and collar of a shirt, shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use. Any markings or trimming on the front or side of a playing garment and objects such as jewellery worn by a player shall not be so conspicuous or brightly reflecting as to unsight an opponent.
8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
9. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
10. All competitors must report to the Control Desk on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
11. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event. Note: Maximum of two events on one day per player.
12. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.
13. Racket testing may take place.
14. All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.
15. All participants and attendees at Table Tennis England events are subject to Table Tennis England Codes of Conduct. See [here](#).
16. TTE, the Organisers and the Referee will not tolerate bad language or verbal abuse of volunteers, officials, staff or venue staff, nor a failure to follow the operational directions of stewards and event staff. We will treat all such instances extremely seriously and will take disciplinary action if necessary. For further details, please see the Table Tennis England [Workforce Protection Policy](#).
17. Competitors in the Cadet events must have been born in 2012 or later and for the Junior events must have been born in 2008 or later.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entry Form - Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to John Dennison, 117 Colchester Road, London E10 6HD, Tel: 07831808400, email to john@fusionttc.co.uk. Payments should be made payable to Fusion Table Tennis Club: Account 18396682, Sort No. 602477. Entries without fees will not be accepted.

2. Draw - The draw will be made on the Thursday before the tournament, shortly before play, at Fusion TTC, Unit 2 Stockholm Road, London SE16 3LP. Once completed, the draw will be sent out before the start of the tournament and put on the club's website and social media.

3. Admission - There will be no charge for admission, including for parents/guardians of Junior or Cadet competitors.

4. Tables and Equipment - Play throughout will be on 10 Donic tables with Donic nets & posts, Donic 3 Star White plastic balls. Tables are enclosed by individual court surrounds. Minimum height of the playing area (floor to ceiling) is not less than 8m. Sports rubber flooring is used throughout, with general (not over-table) LED lighting at a minimum height of 8m above the floor. Court size will be 9m x 4.5m x 3m.

5. Score Indicators - Score indicators will be used for all matches.

6. Doping - Doping control tests may take place.

7. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practise on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee.

8. Changing Facilities - Changing rooms are available on site with disabled facilities, including hot showers.

9. Car Parking - Car parking (at owner's risk, free of charge) is available on the road and in the surrounding area.

10. Catering - Refreshments will be on sale throughout serving breakfast, lunch and tea; full meals are not provided.

11. Prizes - Cash prizes are awarded to the Winner, Runner-up and Semi-Finalists (where applicable) in each event - see the table below.

12. Photo/livestreaming - Fusion TTC may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to) using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications.
