

# Bring Someone Into the Game – Win a bespoke London 2026-inspired Butterfly table

## Referral Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

### 1. Promoter

The promoter of this prize draw is **Table Tennis England, Bradwell Road, Loughton Lodge, Milton Keynes, MK8 9LA** ("Table Tennis England", "we", "us" or "our").

The prize draw is organised and administered solely and independently by Table Tennis England and is not sponsored, administered or operated in association with any other organisation.

---

### 2. Promotion Period

The promotion opens on **24 September 2026** ("Opening Date").

The promotion closes at **23:59 on 1 November 2026** ("Closing Date").

Only qualifying referrals completed between the Opening Date and Closing Date will be eligible.

Entries or referrals received before the Opening Date or after the Closing Date will not be considered.

---

### 3. Eligibility

The prize draw is open to residents of England who hold a valid individual Table Tennis England membership for the **2026/27 membership season**.

Eligible individual membership categories are:

- Supporter
- Club Play
- Compete
- Compete Plus
- Coach Membership
- Coach Plus

The referring member must hold a valid eligible membership at the time the prize draw takes place.

There is no minimum age to participate. However, where the selected winner is under the age of 18, their parent or legal guardian must claim and accept the prize on their behalf and will be responsible for agreeing delivery arrangements.

The following individuals are not eligible to participate:

- employees of Table Tennis England;
- members of the Table Tennis England Board;
- immediate family members of Table Tennis England employees or Board members;
- any person directly involved in the administration of this promotion or prize draw.

Table Tennis England reserves the right to request reasonable evidence of eligibility before awarding the prize.

---

## 4. How to participate

To participate, an eligible Table Tennis England member must encourage another individual to take out an individual Table Tennis England membership during the Promotion Period.

The person taking out the membership must enter the referring member's valid **TTID** in the referral field during the membership sign-up process.

The TTID must be submitted as part of the membership application and cannot be added retrospectively after the membership registration has been completed.

Each qualifying membership registration containing a valid eligible TTID will create **one prize draw entry** for the member whose TTID has been entered.

---

## 5. Qualifying referrals

A qualifying referral is a completed individual Table Tennis England membership registration during the Promotion Period which includes a valid TTID belonging to an eligible referring member.

Qualifying referrals may include:

- brand-new Table Tennis England members;
- former or lapsed members returning to membership;
- existing members taking out an additional eligible membership;
- members upgrading to another eligible individual membership.

Both **free and paid individual memberships** can qualify.

Each qualifying referral has the same value for the purposes of the prize draw regardless of the membership product selected or the price paid.

For example:

- 1 qualifying referral = 1 prize draw entry
- 5 qualifying referrals = 5 prize draw entries
- 10 qualifying referrals = 10 prize draw entries

There is no set maximum number of genuine qualifying referrals that an eligible member may make during the Promotion Period.

Bulk membership uploads administered by Table Tennis England membership administration team are not eligible.

---

## 6. Referral TTIDs

Only one referring TTID may be entered against each qualifying membership registration.

The TTID entered at the point of registration will be treated as the nominated referrer for that membership.

TTIDs cannot be:

- added after registration;
- substituted after registration;
- transferred to another referring member;
- retrospectively amended for the purposes of this promotion.

It is the responsibility of the referring member and the person completing the membership application to ensure that the correct TTID is supplied and entered.

Table Tennis England accepts no responsibility for incorrect, incomplete or mistyped TTIDs.

---

## **7. Self-referrals**

Participants may not refer themselves.

A membership registration where the referral TTID belongs to the individual taking out or registering the membership will not generate a valid prize draw entry.

Table Tennis England may remove any entries which it reasonably determines to be self-referrals.

---

## **8. Cancelled, refunded or invalid memberships**

A referral will only remain eligible where the associated membership registration remains valid.

Where a membership is:

- cancelled;
- refunded;
- reversed;
- identified as a duplicate;
- created in error;
- found to contain false or misleading information;
- otherwise determined by Table Tennis England to be invalid,

the corresponding referral entry may be excluded from the prize draw.

---

## **9. Genuine registrations, fraud and misuse**

All referrals must relate to genuine individual membership registrations.

Duplicate, fake, automated, spam or artificially created accounts will not qualify.

Table Tennis England reserves the right to investigate referral activity where it identifies:

- unusually high referral volumes;
- multiple registrations apparently relating to the same individual;
- suspicious or repeated contact details;
- automated or bulk registrations;
- artificial membership creation;

- attempts to manipulate the referral process;
- any other activity which reasonably suggests misuse of the promotion.

Table Tennis England may request further information where reasonably necessary to verify the validity of an entry.

Fraudulent, manipulated, artificial, duplicate or otherwise invalid referrals will be removed.

Table Tennis England reserves the right to disqualify a participant where it reasonably believes that person has attempted to manipulate, abuse or circumvent the promotion or prize draw process.

---

## 10. Technical failures and unsuccessful registrations

Table Tennis England will take reasonable steps to operate the promotion correctly but cannot guarantee uninterrupted availability of its membership systems or other digital services.

Table Tennis England will not be responsible for entries which are not successfully recorded due to circumstances outside its reasonable control, including:

- website or membership-platform outages;
- connectivity failures;
- interrupted or incomplete membership registrations;
- technical errors;
- incorrect or incomplete TTIDs;
- browser, device or network failures;
- other technical circumstances which prevent the referral information from being successfully recorded.

A referral must be successfully recorded within Table Tennis England's membership records during the Promotion Period in order to qualify.

Referral information cannot be retrospectively added where it was not successfully recorded during the membership registration process.

---

## 11. The prize

There is **one prize**.

The winner will receive one **Butterfly Spirit Match 22 Rollaway Table Tennis Table featuring a bespoke ITTF World Team Table Tennis Championships Finals London 2026-inspired design.**

The bespoke table has an estimated value of approximately **£1,600** based on its value during the ITTF World Team Table Tennis Championships Finals London 2026.

For context, the standard unbranded Butterfly Spirit Match 22 table is available separately through retail channels, including TeesSport, at a lower retail price. The bespoke London 2026 design and history of the prize table form part of the prize being offered under this promotion.

The prize table is **not brand new** and has previously been used. Minor cosmetic wear and tear should therefore be expected.

The table was not used as a competition table during the ITTF World Team Table Tennis Championships Finals London 2026.

---

## **12. Prize specification**

The Butterfly Spirit Match 22 includes:

- 22mm playing top suitable for match play;
- Centrefold rollaway system;
- strong steel frame and stable undercarriage;
- height adjusters on all four legs;
- double locking system on each half;
- playback facility;
- Butterfly Clip net and post set;
- bat and ball holder;
- folding design for movement and storage.

The table conforms to EN 14468-1 safety requirements.

Approximate dimensions when in use:

**275cm long x 153cm wide x 77cm high**  
(9' x 5' x 2'6")

Approximate dimensions when stored:

**158cm high x 169cm wide x 64cm deep**  
(5'3" x 5'7" x 1'2")

Approximate unpacked weight:

**125kg**

Minimal assembly is required before first use.

Any photographs or visual representations of the prize used in promotional materials are illustrative. Minor differences caused by previous use, production, branding or finishing may be present.

---

### **13. Prize value and availability**

The prize is offered as described and there is:

- no cash alternative;
- no alternative prize;
- no substitution for another product;
- no entitlement to receive the equivalent monetary value of the prize.

The prize is non-exchangeable and non-transferable by Table Tennis England, except that the winner may nominate an alternative delivery recipient in accordance with section 15 below.

---

### **14. Winner selection**

The prize draw will take place **within 48 hours of the Closing Date**.

Every valid qualifying referral will represent one entry in the draw for the member whose TTID was supplied.

The winning referral will be selected at random from all eligible entries.

The draw will be conducted using either:

- a verifiably random computer selection process;
- another random selection process conducted under the supervision of an independent person.

Table Tennis England will retain appropriate records demonstrating how the winning entry was selected.

---

## **15. Using or donating the prize**

The winner may decide how they wish to use the table.

They may:

- retain the table for their own use;
- gift it to another individual;
- donate it to a table tennis club or other sports club;
- donate it to a school;
- donate it to a community centre;
- provide it to a charity or community organisation;
- nominate another suitable venue or organisation to receive it.

Where the winner nominates an organisation or third-party venue to receive the prize, Table Tennis England must receive confirmation from an authorised representative of that organisation that:

- it agrees to accept the prize;
- it agrees to accept delivery;
- it has an appropriate location for the table;
- the delivery requirements in these terms can be met.

The winner remains responsible for identifying and obtaining agreement from their chosen recipient.

Table Tennis England is under no obligation to identify an alternative recipient on behalf of the winner.

---

## **16. Delivery and collection**

Table Tennis England will cover the cost of one delivery of the prize to an eligible address in England.

Delivery will be made using a specialist two-person delivery service.

The nominated delivery point must be:

- at ground-floor level;
- reasonably accessible to the delivery team;
- suitable for the size and weight of the table;
- capable of safely receiving and storing the table.

The winner is responsible for checking access before confirming the delivery location.

This includes ensuring that entrances, doors, corridors and other access points are sufficiently large and accessible for delivery.

Table Tennis England will not be responsible where delivery cannot be completed because the nominated location does not satisfy these requirements.

If the winner wishes to donate the prize to another organisation or venue, delivery will only be arranged after Table Tennis England has received confirmation and acceptance from that recipient.

Collection of the table may be arranged as an alternative to delivery by agreement with Table Tennis England.

Any costs or arrangements associated with moving the table after the initial delivery or collection are the responsibility of the winner or nominated recipient.

---

## 17. Winner notification

The selected winner will be contacted using the contact details associated with their Table Tennis England membership.

Table Tennis England will make reasonable attempts to contact the winner.

The winner will have **14 days from the date of the first winner notification** to respond and claim the prize.

The winner may be required to provide reasonable evidence of:

- identity;
- age;
- residence in England;
- valid Table Tennis England membership;
- any other information reasonably necessary to confirm eligibility and arrange delivery.

Where the winner is under 18, their parent or legal guardian must respond and claim the prize on their behalf.

---

## 18. Unclaimed prize and redraw

If the selected winner:

- does not respond within 14 days;
- cannot reasonably be contacted;
- declines the prize;
- is found to be ineligible;
- fails to provide information reasonably required to verify eligibility;
- is unable or unwilling to accept the prize in accordance with these terms.

their winning entry will be void.

A replacement winner will then be selected using the same random selection process described in section 14.

The replacement winner will also have 14 days from first notification to claim the prize.

This process may be repeated where reasonably necessary until an eligible winner accepts the prize.

---

## **19. Winner communications and publicity**

The winner will be featured in Table Tennis England member communications in connection with the promotion and award of the prize.

Where appropriate, Table Tennis England may ask the winner to participate in reasonable publicity relating to the promotion, such as a photograph, short interview or announcement.

Where the winner is under 18, any participation in publicity involving their image or personal information will require appropriate parent or guardian involvement and any consent required by law.

Any use of personal information in connection with winner publicity will be handled in accordance with applicable data protection requirements and Table Tennis England's privacy notice.

---

## **20. Confirmation that the prize has been awarded**

Table Tennis England may publish or otherwise make available information reasonably necessary to demonstrate that a valid prize has been awarded.

This may include the winner's surname and county or other appropriately limited information.

An eligible winner may object to or request a reduction in the amount of information published about them for legitimate privacy reasons.

This does not prevent Table Tennis England from providing winner information to a competent regulatory authority where required to do so.

---

## **21. Personal data**

Personal information processed in connection with the promotion will be used only as reasonably necessary to:

- administer the referral promotion;
- record and validate referral entries;
- identify and remove invalid or fraudulent entries;
- conduct the prize draw;
- verify the winner's eligibility;
- contact the winner;
- arrange delivery or collection of the prize;
- demonstrate that a valid award has taken place;
- comply with applicable legal or regulatory obligations;
- publicity as outlined in Section 19 of these T&Cs.

Personal information will be processed in accordance with Table Tennis England's privacy notice:

Participation in the promotion does not constitute consent to receive additional marketing communications where separate consent or another lawful basis is required.

---

## **22. Referral totals**

Table Tennis England will record referral information for the purposes of administering the promotion.

Participants will not be provided with live or individual referral totals during the Promotion Period.

Table Tennis England will determine qualifying entries using its membership records following the Closing Date.

---

## **23. Responsibility for third-party recipients**

Where the winner chooses to gift or donate the table to another person, organisation or venue, that decision is the winner's responsibility.

Table Tennis England does not endorse, sponsor or accept responsibility for any organisation selected by the winner simply because it receives the prize.

The recipient will be responsible for the table following completion of delivery.

---

## **24. Liability**

Nothing in these terms excludes or limits liability where it would be unlawful to do so, including liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation.

Subject to those limitations, Table Tennis England will not be responsible for loss, damage or expense arising from participation in the promotion or acceptance, possession or use of the prize where that loss:

- was not reasonably foreseeable;
- results from circumstances outside Table Tennis England's reasonable control;
- results from misuse of the prize;
- results from failure to follow manufacturer guidance or safety instructions;
- results from the non-suitability of a location selected by the winner or nominated recipient;
- arises after delivery from moving, storing, installing or using the table.

Nothing in these terms affects any statutory rights that cannot lawfully be excluded.

---

## **25. Events outside Table Tennis England's reasonable control**

If circumstances outside Table Tennis England's reasonable control materially affect the fair or proper administration of the promotion, Table Tennis England may take such steps as are reasonably necessary to protect participants and preserve the integrity of the promotion.

This may include suspending or cancelling the promotion where there is no reasonable alternative.

Table Tennis England will not amend the terms or operation of the promotion merely to avoid awarding the advertised prize or because participation is higher or lower than expected.

Any material change which becomes necessary will be communicated to participants as clearly and promptly as reasonably practicable.

---

## **26. Decisions and administration**

Table Tennis England is responsible for determining whether a referral satisfies these terms.

Where there is a genuine administrative error, Table Tennis England may correct its records where doing so does not unfairly disadvantage other participants.

Table Tennis England's decisions regarding the validation of entries and administration of the promotion will be final, subject to any rights participants have under applicable law.

## **27. Rights reserved**

Table Tennis England reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions in the event of unforeseen circumstances. Any changes to the competition will be made in accordance with UK law. ## **27. Governing law**

These terms and conditions and the promotion are governed by the laws of **England and Wales**.
